ABOUT MUSICIANSHIP

Students gain an understanding of music as a language and learn to apply their skills to become better musicians, no matter what instrument they play. Musicianship is a practical, comprehensive program covering music theory, rhythmic and melodic dictation, ear training, and sight-singing with an emphasis on real-time performance skills – in other words, teaching music without the instrument. Class meets once per week.

KEYS OF INSPIRATION

KOI gives students of all levels and backgrounds a chance to experience the power of music by encouraging piano performance as a means of social development for youth. At OCMD, KOI group piano classes are divided into two levels, A and B. Each class meets twice per week.
