



RACIAL DISPARITIES

Native Hawaiians or Pacific Islanders in Boulder County, CO are 8X overrepresented in homelessness relative to their makeup of the general population. The same is true for those identifying as Black or African American (5.5X), Native American or Alaska Native (3.6X), and Multi-Racial (2.4X).
