



RACIAL DISPARITIES

Native Hawaiians or Pacific Islanders in Metro Denver are 10.0X overrepresented in homelessness relative to their makeup of the general population. The same is true for those identifying as Native American or Alaska Native (3.0X), Black or African American (3.3X), and Multi-Racial (1.3X).
