

#### **REGION 12 GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS**

- 1. <u>USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT:</u> Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline: 2) exhibitions: 3) games and races: 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
- 2. USEF FEES: Every horse in this competition shall pay a \$23 Fee (\$15 fee for Drugs & Medication and an \$8 fee for USEF).
- 3. USEF RULES: EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. See USEF Rule AR for Arabian Horse rules, class descriptions & judging specifications. Changes in USEF rules will automatically become a part of this Prize List. Show Committee reserves right to make such changes in procedure, personnel, rules & regulations as deemed by them to be in the best interest of the show. USEF considers Regional Show, Hunter/Jumper and Dressage classes to be inclusive as a single show.
- 4. ARENAS Descriptions & Admission: No person permitted in arena during classes except judges, assistants, exhibitors in class & show photographer. Headers not permitted in arena until summoned by order of Judge. All arenas have custom blended, all weather, GGT footing. Arena measurements: WEC Grand Arena: 320' x 400', Indoor 1: 171' x 530', Indoor 4: 192' x 525', & Hunter 3 & 4: 175' x 300'
- 5. AGE OF HORSE: Horses, except in Yearling Sweepstakes classes, must be 2 years of age to enter Mare and Stallion Championship Breeding Classes. Geldings must be 1 year old to enter In Hand Championship Classes. For competition purposes any horse is considered to be 1 year old on the first day of January following 14. CROSS ENTRIES: Cross entries at these shows are prohibited between the the actual day of foaling.
- 6. AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches 15. CRUELTY TO OR THE ABUSE OF A HORSE BY ANY PERSON AT and the person(s) signing the entry blank in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event Membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA Single Event Membership. Single Event Membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National competitions. Exhibitors in Walk-Trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with competition card at AHA Regional and National competitions. Exhibitors in Lead Line classes or parent/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5/12)
- 7. AOTR/AOTD/JOTR/AAOTR/AATR CLASSES: All riders 19 years or older in amateur owner classes must have in their possession amateur certification issued by USEF or make application for such certification at least one hour prior to showing in these classes. Applications may be secured from the Show Secretary. Leased horses may not be shown by Lessee in amateur owner classes, unless Lessee and Lessor are members of the same family. Combined ownership is allowed in amateurowner classes only if all owners are members of the same family. See USEF GR 123 for definition of "family." <u>USEF Farm Registration Certificate must accompany</u> entries made in farm name that will be shown in Amateur Owner classes. Horses entered in amateur owner and JOTR classes must be registered in the name of exhibitor or a member of exhibitor's family. The sale of a horse does not eliminate

this registration requirement (contracts of sale or bill of sale will not be accepted) USEF AR 101.2.

- 8. ARRIVAL TIME: Stalls available 8:00 AM on Sunday, Apr. 30, 2023. You may make arrangements with the barn manager for early arrivals at a fee of \$30.00 per stall, per day, used for any purpose, including: tack, feed, dressing room, sitting area, etc. Early arrival fees will be charged at the show when verified by Show Management. Exhibitors arriving prior to 8:00 AM. on Sunday, Apr. 30 will be charged a fee of \$30 per stall, per day used for any purpose. EARLY AR- RIVAL STALLS ARE LIMITED AND MAY NOT BE YOUR SHOW STALLS.
- 9. ATTIRE: Riders & handlers must be dressed appropriately. Show Committee may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably attired to appear before an audience. Headers in driving classes must be properly attired. A white smock is usual.
- 10. AWARDS: Top five awards will be made regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed 5 awards) will receive Breeders Sweepstakes payout points, AHA horse achievement awards, high point horse achievement award, high point achievement award and distance award points. All awards not claimed by the close of the awards room on the last day of classes, will be forfeited. Awards will not be mailed to exhibitors after the event.
- 11. CALL FOR CLASSES: Classes will be called promptly. There will be 3 calls for classes whenever possible. The first two calls will be made at reasonable intervals. The third & final call will be made while ribbons are being awarded in preceding class. Exception: First class of each session should be at the gate at the scheduled time for commencement of the session. In classes where horses compete collectively, two minutes will be allowed after first horse in class enters ring, after which time the gate will be closed. Exhibitors are requested to come to warm-up ring 15 minutes prior to class. However, it may become necessary to limit horses & number of attendants in warm-up ring to those showing in next class.
- 12. CAMPERS / RV SLIPS / GOLF CARTS: Reserve only through WEC at www.worldequestriancenter.com.. Under Ocala, click Golf Cart Rentals for both.
- 13. COVID-19 ACTION PLAN: Every Region 12 exhibitor and participant agrees to abide by the US Equestrian Federation COVID-19 Action Plan Requirements. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, all programs, properties, events and related specifications are subject to change in accordance with federal, state and local laws and regulations. The plan can be found here: https://www.usef.org/media/coronavirus- resources.
- Country English Pleasure classes and the English Pleasure and Pleasure Driving classes at the same show.
- THESE RECOGNIZED SHOWS ARE FORBIDDEN. Excessive use of a whip on any horse in a stall, runway, schooling area, show ring or elsewhere on the show grounds, before or during a show, by any person, constitutes a violation and renders the offender subject to penalty.
- 16. **DEPARTURE TIME:** All horses and equipment must be clear of the grounds by Noon on Monday, May 8, 2023.
- 17. DISCIPLINE: Exhibitors are hereby notified that the AHA Board of Directors will strictly enforce and actively support all AHA, USEF and/or CEF rules regarding sportsmanship, conduct & courtesy at all AHA Recognized shows and events. This includes but is not limited to Rules that govern owners, exhibitors, agents, trainers, managers, riders, drivers, handlers, competition officials, competition employees & members of the families of the above, individual members of AHA or any person who acts in a manner in violation of the Rules or deemed prejudicial to its best interests . Any AHA and/or USEF violations committed will be subject to the AHA, USEF and/or CEF penalties.
- 18. **DISPUTES:** Disputes, if any, over Regional Classes which cannot be settled by the Region 12 Show Committee shall be referred to the AHA National and Regional Classes Committee.

- 19. DISQUALIFICATIONS: All horses doctored in any way, artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming into the show arena will be disqualified, if it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made, or caused to be made, a false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the Judges in the performance of their duties, he/ she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In the case of any animal being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified animal & the alternate for that class shall move up to a placing.
- **20. DIVISION OF CLASSES:** Classes will be split at the discretion of Show Management. Class splits will be decided upon the number of entries with consideration of arena size and location. Class splits will be posted at the Show Office.

**Exception:** Sweepstakes Sport Horse Under Saddle AOTR classes will not be further split by age, as they have already been split by type.

- **21.** <u>DOGS/ANIMALS LEASH REQUIREMENTS:</u> Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times while on property. Any dog that is deemed aggressive by WEC staff or security will be asked to be removed from property or put away in the owner's residence.
- **22.** EGYPTIAN RELATED CLASSES: See page 34 for list of classes and rules regarding these classes. NOTE: These classes are not recognized by AHA nor USEF.
- 23. ELIGIBILITY: Refer to the current Qualification requirements on the AHA website.
- 24. ENTRIES: Pre-entries close April 1, 2023. Email entries will be accepted, if sent as one (1) complete document. Entries postmarked after April 1st will be charged a \$50 per horse post entry fee. If making a late entry, do not mail to the Show Secretary after April 19th. Bring it to the show, being sure the late entry is made before the show starts at 8 am on Tuesday, May 2nd. Entries must be accompanied by full payment in order to be processed. Open checks sent with entries will be filled out and deposited when entry is processed. Entries sent with no payment will be considered post entries and charged the post entry fees. Due to bookkeeping procedures, fees cannot be split between exhibitors. Entries must be properly made on the official entry form in the name of the legal owner only, giving the legal owner's complete address. Any deviation between Registration paper & entry form must have a valid reason, i.e., contract, lease, bill of sale; copies of which must accompany entries (For AOTR/JOTR classes refer to Rule #7). Entries postmarked by closing date will be sent an email acknowledgement. Entries must be signed by the owner/agent, the trainer, and by ALL riders/drivers/handlers. If under age 18, a parent/guardian or the trainer must sign entry blank on minor's behalf, signing their name. "Junior (Minor) Exhibitor Consent" must also be completed. JUNIORS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO HAVE THEIR NAME SIGNED ON ENTRY FORMS!! Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in the preparation of entry blanks. Packets/exhibitor numbers will not be released until all entries are complete.
- **25.** EQUITATION: All classes shall be conducted in accordance with current USEF rules as modified by AHA. Equitation rules are found in the current AHA Handbook. Formal attire is permitted, but not required, in performance classes held after 6:00 p.m.
- **26. FARRIER:** Any Farrier other than the Official Show Farrier must pay a Commercial Vendor Fee of \$350 and set up in a designated area for farriers. Exhibitors are cautioned that the USEF Steward and the judges are the final authorities on measuring the shoe and/or foot.
- 27. <u>FEED & BEDDING</u>: NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ARE ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT ON THE WEC GROUNDS (a \$30 CLEAN UP FEE PER STALL will be applied to anyone not following these restrictions). Shavings and feed can be ordered through WEC.

- 28. HALTER CLASSES: The one specified person assisting with entrance of inhand horses into the ring, in the designated controlled paddock, will be allowed to use only the same length whip and appendages as are currently allowed for the individual handling the horse. Rule reference AR114.2: Whips are to be no longer than 6' including snapper/lash/appendage. Small appendages (no more than 12 inches in length) of ribbon, plastic, etc. are permitted. The designated person will not hit or use any other objects, such as trash cans, walls, etc. to make any noise. In addition, the use of plastic or paper bags of any type or size is prohibited in assisting with entrance(s) into the arena. Should this rule/policy be violated, a warning card may be issued to both the handler and the designated per- son or groom who initiates this violation. Order of go will be posted by horse's birth date. Horses must enter arena in assigned order at a walk and proceed at a trot after entering the gate until lined up. Horses to be inspected for signs of abuse by designated Steward prior to entrance into ring for judging. Manner of inspection will be at the discretion of Show Management. Purebred Stallions & Mares and Yearling Colts & Fillies will be lined up in the order selected by each respective judge. All halter classes will use the "In Ring" procedure.
- 29. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Florida regulations require that all equines be covered by official interstate health certificates, issued by a licensed veterinarian, showing that the animals are free from any symptoms of any infectious or communicable disease. The certificate shall include the name of the owner and address, destination in Florida, number of horses examined, the name, registration number (s), if any, tattoo, if any, sex, age, rectal temperature, color, and markings of each animal listed. Health certificates will become void after 30 days from issue. Health certificates must show animals to be negative to an equine infectious anemia test within the past 12 months. Date of test and approved laboratory must be shown on health certificate. Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian. 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Com- petition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration. 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration. 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested. 5. Com- petition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee.
- **30. IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS:** Every horse in the show will be assigned an identification number and this number must be worn by exhibitors when the horse is being shown. Any exhibitor using a wrong number or having no number may be penalized at the Judge's discretion.
- 31. INDEMNITY & NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSE: All entries are accepted with the understanding that Region 12 and the World Equestrian Center will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Commission but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify Region 12 and the World Equestrian Center against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. Submitting of an entry form to Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance of each person signing same of the provision herein set forth.
- **32. JUDGING SYSTEMS:** All Region 12 classes will be judged by the AHA MOS system described in AHA Handbook with the exception of Dressage, Western Dressage, Hunter/Jumper and Sport Horse. The call judge will call the gaits in all Regional performance classes. Judges' cards will be posted after each session.

- **33. JUNIOR EXHIBITORS:** Children eligible for Junior Exhibitor classes shall not have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday as of December 1<sup>st</sup> of the previous year.
- 34. JUNIOR HORSE CLASSES: Junior horses are five years of age and under.
- 35. MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. Exhibitors that bring personal vehicles will be required to carry appropriate insurance and provide proof.
- **36. OFFICIALS:** In the event that due to illness or failure of a Show Official to attend this show or perform his duties, the Show Management reserves the right to substitute a Show Official. No one shall approach or contact a Judge with regard to a decision unless they first obtain permission from the Show Steward who may arrange an appointment with the Judge at a proper time & place.
- **37. PA SYSTEM:** Due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system & class calls over that system are considered a courtesy. The exhibitor is responsible to have his horse at the gate at the prescribed time. While every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system, no refund will be made, section changed, or protest upheld based on a PA failure.
- 38. POST ENTRIES: Post Entries accepted for all classes except Dressage. Dressage post entries will only be allowed at the discretion of management if ride times are available. Post entries will be charged an add'l fee of \$50 per horse for entries postmarked after April 1st and received before the show starts. Once the show starts, all new entries will pay a post entry fee of \$50 per class if entered by the preceding session, for a total of \$115 per class. Post entries using Messaging or Text Messages are not accepted at all. ALL CLASSES FOR THE MORNING SESSIONS MUST BE ENTERED BY 6PM THE EVENING BEFORE.

  Official start of show is 8:00 AM, Tuesday, May 2, 2023

If an entry fails to enter by the above guidelines, then a courtesy class entry fee of \$200 **per class** will be charged.

- **39. PROFESSIONAL SERVICES** or consultations performed by Show Vet or Farrier outside the show ring shall be on private fee basis.
- **40. PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR:** Any rider may wear protective headgear in any division or class without penalty from the judge. USEF strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear. It is the responsibility of the rider, parent, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition. Refer to current USEF Rule Book.
- 41. QUALIFICATIONS: See AHA Qualification chart.
- 42. <u>REFUNDS:</u> All fees (except Office Fees & 4% credit card fees) cancelled before the April 1st deadline will be refunded. **No refunds after the closing date.**STALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE ONCE THEY ARE ORDERED—NO REFUND MADE AT THE SHOW. All refunds will be mailed within 30 days of the show's ending date.

**SCRATCH FORM:** Scratches using Messaging or Text Message are not accepted at all.. No credit will be given for scratched classes unless another class is entered, by the same horse, at the time of the scratch.

**43. REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:** Horses to be shown in classes designated for Purebreds (Arabian) must be registered with the Arabian Horse Association, Inc., or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry; or, if under one year of age, be eligible for registry, and registration applied for and must be entered under full registered name. Horses to be shown in classes designated for Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian (HA/AA) must be registered with the Arabian Horse Association, Inc.; or be eligible for registry & registration applied for and must be entered under full registered name. **NOTE:** For competition purposes, ANY horse is considered to be one year old on the first day of January following the actual date of foaling. Therefore, a Certificate of Registration MUST have been issued for horses entered in the Sweepstakes Yearling Classes.

# 44. RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS: Exhibitors who fails to settle indebtedness to this show will automatically be barred from taking part whatsoever in any Recognized Show until settlement is made. In addition, \$100 will be assessed each time a check is returned unpaid or \$65 each time a credit card is declined. If management must avail itself of the remedies under the USEF rules, an additional \$100 penalty will be assessed for a total of \$200/\$150 (maximum). After 2nd time NSF check is received, exhibitor must have cash or certified bank check. In addition, any horse(s) entered with a returned check or declined credit card will be subject to post entry fees, unless all fees paid by the returned check/declined credit card are paid in full by the pre-entry closing date. PREMIUM STALLING WILL NOT BE ASSIGNED UNLESS FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS HAVE BEEN MET IN FULL.

- **45. RIDER/DRIVER CLARIFICATION:** Please note that rider/drivers /handler cannot be changed once a class starts. With a sectioned class, class is not over until the final is run. Therefore, a rider/driver/handler who performs in section A or B must also ride/drive/handle in the final class. Likewise, the same rider/driver/ handler cannot perform in both section A & B of the same class on two different horses.
- 46. <u>SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:</u> Effective immediately, any competition with the start date of September 1, 2020 and later will be required to include the following Safe Sport statement in the Rules and Regulation section of the prize list: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. - 47. **SECURITY:** WEC 24-hour Security: 352.414.7960
- **48.** <u>SHARPS CONTAINERS:</u> Sharps Containers: USEF GR1210.4 Competition management shall place a minimum of one Sharps Container per each competition, whether or not stabling is provided. Additionally, at least one Sharps Container per fifty occupied stalls for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments in convenient locations in barns housing competition horses.


#### 49. SHOW OFFICE HOURS:

On show days, the office will open one (1) hour before the first session of each day and will close nightly at 9 PM or at the beginning of the last class of the day, whichever comes first. The office will close one hour following the last class on Sunday. **The Show Office will not be open on Monday after the show.** Any variations in the schedule will be announced and posted on the show office door. Exhibitors are requested to report to show office as soon as possible after arrival to pick up show packets, correct any pending items, or make entries. Trainers with six or more owners are encouraged to make an appointment.

- 50. SHOW TABS: Any exhibitor wishing to add classes or make changes in entries at the show office will be required to leave credit card information or a signed check payable to "Region 12". Show Tabs must be closed out and settled by 6:00 p.m. on Sunday. Those accounts that have not been settle by exhibitors will be charged a \$25 closing fee by the show office, checks will be filled out, and the accounts will be closed. For your convenience, we suggest that you audit your Show Tab and make settlement at the earliest possible time to avoid delays and to obtain account information.
- 51. **STABLING:** All stalls have doors and are permanent concrete stalls with stable comfort mattress systems and fans in a climate-controlled barn, 12'X12' and 12'X14'. Stalls may not be occupied by more than one horse at a time.
- 52. STALLS BARN DAMAGE: Exhibitors will be financially responsible for any damage to their stalls on the premises. Do not put nails into the side-walls. Stalls must be vacated in their original condition. Stalls may not be structurally altered in any way. ALL CHARGES FOR DAMAGES THAT WEC CHARGES REGION 12 SHOW WILL BE BILLED BACK TO THE EXHIBITOR. This charge will be automatically added to your final invoice at the Show Secretary's office. Charges from the WEC billed to the Region 12 Show for removal of lumber or other items used for decorating purposes will be billed back to the exhibitor after the conclusion of the show. A \$50 clean up fee/stall will be charged for stalls with trash left behind.
- 53. **STALLS PREMIUM:** Region 12 Premium Stalls will be assigned by the Region 12 Stabling Manager, based on Sponsorship Level and previous sponsor history. Overall pattern to optimize the use of barns, number of horses and payment for stalls being made in full prior to the closing date of the show. Failure to receive payment in full for any reason, will remove the exhibitor from the premium stalling

- areas that are being made available for the 2023 Show. Questions please contact either your designated Sponsorship or Stabling Point of Contact.
- 54. **STALLIONS:** May be shown by Ladies or Junior Exhibitors in all classes except Walk/Trot. No HA/AA stallion, two years or older, may be shown in any In Hand class open to HA/AAs. HA/AA Stallions may be shown in performance- classes. HA/AA Stallions may be shown in all Sport Horse Classes.
- 55. TACK CHANGES must be reported to the Paddock Manager at least two classes ahead to permit proper notification to ring officials. A maximum three- minute hold will be allowed. Exhibitor requesting hold must notify gate promptly when tack change has been completed so class can enter ring without unnecessary delay. All tack changes must be made in paddock area. Your cooperation will help minimize delays between classes.
- 56. **UPDATES:** Any corrections or changes to the class schedule or rules will be published on Region 12 web site: **www.aharegion12.com** or during the show by postings at the Show Office.
- 57. **TBA CLASSES**: TBA classes may be any class on the AHA class list or that is recognized by AHA. The TBA classes must not be a duplicate of any other classes. TBAs are given on a first come first served basis only and must be reserved with the show secretary and **must be approved by the show committee**. Show management reserves the right to allocate TBA slots in a manner to facilitate the flow of the show. If a TBA class is not requested the class number will be canceled and the next class will begin immediately. There will be 10 TBA Classes available.





#### **ENTRY AGREEMENT**

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) Handbook / Directory and Competition Prize List and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.

I AGREE as a Horse Show Participant (or Parent/Guardian of Participant if a minor) to waive all claims which may otherwise arise from, including but not limited to infectious bacteria, viruses, fungi/mold, parasites or other agents which may be present at the Horse Show (and most other outdoor locations) and can cause infection in humans, as well as in animals.

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. Cross entries are prohibited between the Spotlight Futurity Hunter Pleasure Maturity 5 YO -ATR and Spotlight Futurity English Pleasure Maturity class at the same competition.

Cross entries are prohibited between the Spotlight Futurity Western Pleasure Maturity 5 YO -ATR and the Spotlight Futurity English Pleasure Maturity Class at the same competition.

These two amendments will ensure that we have appropriate representation of CEP/ EP horses in the two Spotlight CEP/EP classes. We want the horses in the classes to truly represent the specifications and function of a saddleseat horse. This amendment should take effect immediately as it does not impact nominations or breeding but performance of our horses age 3 and older. Furthermore, it only prohibits cross entering at the same competition. (AS AN EXAMPLE, if a horse at 3yrs of age is shown as a hunter at the May 2022 show and then matures into more of a CEP horse - it could enter and show at the May 2023 show in the EP futurity but will not be able to show in the hunter spotlight futurity class at that same show.)

<u>USDF Membership Benefits:</u> USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.org.

This competition is recognized by USDF for 2023

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.)

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

#### **Exceptions:**

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those
  sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at
  Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are
  exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot,
  academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM
  identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

#### **Memberships Defined**

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

**Group Membership (GM):** A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards Program and the USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program. **Business Membership (BM):** A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

**Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR):** A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

#### **How to Join USDF**

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:
