CITY OF FREEMAN ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 15

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8.0220

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FREEMAN, HUTCHINSON COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA, THAT TITLE 8, SECTION 8.0220 - "Speed", BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

8.0220 Speed

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on a street or highway at a speed greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions then existing or at a speed in excess of those fixed by this chapter or establish by the City Council or the statues of the State of South Dakota.

When no special hazard exists the following speeds shall be lawful but any speed in excess of said limits shall be prima facie evidence that the speed is not reasonable or prudent, and that it is unlawful:

- a. Fifteen (15) miles per hour when passing a school building or grounds thereof during school recess or while children are going to school or leaving school during opening or closing hours, provided that he City Council by resolution may require a complete stop before passing a school building.
- b. Twenty (20) miles per hour in all other business or residential districts unless otherwise posted.

The driver of every vehicle shall be consistent with the requirements of this section, drive at an appropriate reduced speed when approaching and going around a curve, when approaching and crossing intersection, when traveling upon any narrow roadway, and when a special hazard exists with respect to pedestrians or other traffic or by reason of weather or street conditions.
