Yarn required:

**SEAN SHEEP**

**FLOWERDALE YARN**

1 x 150g ball



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Skill Level  
**Intermediate**



# Angular Scarf *(Intermediate Knitting)*

## MEASUREMENTS

Width at widest point (approx)  
48 cms/19 ins

## SEAN SHEEP FLOWERDALE YARN

1 x 150g ball

## NEEDLES

A pair 6.00mm (US 10), (UK 4) Knitting Needles  
or size that gives correct tension/gauge.

## MATERIALS

A Yarn Needle.

## TENSION/GAUGE

**13 sts and 26 rows to 10 cms/  
4 ins over garter st, using 6.00mm  
(US 10), (UK 4) Needles.**

**Note - Correct tension/gauge is essential for  
a successful handknit.**

**This item has been worked on bigger needles  
than normally recommended.**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**st/s** - stitch/es, **K** - Knit, **RS** - right side, **WS** -  
wrong side, **garter st** - every row knit, **rep** -  
repeat, **M1** - make one st by picking up loop  
that lies before next st, place on left hand needle  
and knit into back of loop, **tog** - together.

## CREATE

### Scarf

Using 6.00mm (US 10), (UK 4) Needles, cast on  
2 sts.

**1st row** (RS) - Knit.

**2nd row** - Knit.

**3rd row** - K1, **M1**, K1 = 3 sts.

Knit 3 rows garter st.

**7th row** - K2, **M1**, K1 = 4 sts.

Knit 3 rows garter st.

**\*\* 11th row** - K2, **M1**, knit to last  
2 sts, K2tog.

**12th row** - Knit.

**13th row** - K2, **M1**, knit to end.

Knit 3 rows garter st. **\*\***

Rep from **\*\*** to **\*\*** until enough yarn remain to  
cast off. Cast off loosely.

## FINISHING

DO NOT PRESS. Using yarn needle, darn in  
ends.
