



This survey was conducted from March 24 - 27, 2022 and included a pool of 500 likely general election voters in Oklahoma. These survey results were weighted based on age, gender, party affiliation, and level of education. This survey has a margin of error of 4.38% at a 95% confidence interval. The poll surveyed both cell phones and landlines and used a combination of live callers and an online panel of likely voters.
