



This survey was conducted from June 6 - 9, 2022 and included a pool of 795 likely voters in Oklahoma. These survey results were weighted based on age, gender, party affiliation, and level of education. This survey has a margin of error of 3.47% at a 95% confidence interval. The poll surveyed both cell phones and landlines and used a combination of live callers and an online panel of likely voters.
