**Auchentoshan 12 year old 40% abv** £5  
Smooth and sweet with notes of tangerine and lime

**Auchentoshan American Oak 40% abv** £4.80  
Vanilla rich with coconut and layers of citrus

**Auchentoshan Three Wood 43% abv** £5.50  
Blackcurrant, orange, plum and raisin with butterscotch finish

**Glenkinchie 12 year old 43 % abv** £6.30  
Fruity palate with stewed fruits, apple, honey and an oaky finish.

## Campbeltown

---

**Longrow 46% abv** £6.35  
Sharp fruity and peaty, with a hint of dry cider to finish

**Glen Scotia 15 year old 46% abv** £19.95  
Plumb fruits with a surprisingly dry finish

**Glen Scotia Double Cask 46% abv** £7.95  
A non-aged mature statement filled with rich spicy fruits, gentle oak and a hint of vanilla

**Hazelburn 10 year old 46% abv** £7  
Triple distilled gives a smooth sweet citrus on the palate with a complex mix of barley and vanilla

**Kilkerran 12 year old 46% abv** £7  
Non-chill filtered, starts fruity but finishes smoothly with butterscotch notes with a light peat

**Cragganmore 12 year old 40% abv** £6  
Sherried 12 year old with malty with cream honey and vanilla notes, floral

**Dalwhinnie 15 year old 43% abv** £6.50  
Smooth and soft with a heather-honey deepness

**Dalwhinnie Winter's Gold 43% abv** £6.6  
Earthy peat, barbecue smoke with a touch of heather

**Glen Grant 10 year old 40% abv** £4.95  
Malty with a gentle peat, aging in bourbon casks offers toffee and vanilla taste

**Glen Grant 16 year old 43% abv** £14.30  
Firm earthy, fruity sweetness with a gentle peat

**Glenfarclas 10 year old 40% abv** £5.50  
Malt, toffee and smoke, finished with long spices

**Glenlivet Founders Reserve 40% abv** £4.95  
Sweet with a touch of anise, with a creamy, oaky warmth to finish

**Knockando 12 year old 43% abv** £5.60  
Diverse notes from citrus to farm, peppered finish. Light and fruity with spicy hints

**Macallan 12 year old 40% abv** £8  
Sherry oak deliciously smooth with rich dried fruits balanced with a wood smoke and spice.

**Aberfeldy 12 year old 40% abv** £6  
A blend of tropical fruits, and floral notes on a soft malt bed

**Ardnamurchan Ad 46.8% abv** £9.50  
Non-chill filtered, a fruity sweet single malt, combination of both peated and unpeated, citrus notes with salted popcorn and dark chocolate.

**Ardmore Legacy 40 % abv** £5  
80% peated and 20% unpeated offers a full bodied yet dry and spicy single malt.

**Balvenie 12 year old 40% abv** £7.60  
Doublwood a mix of ex-bourbon and sherry casks then transferred to oak casks to marry the casks together. Offers a nuttiness, cinnamon spiciness.

**Dalmore 12 year old 40% abv** £7.70  
Marmalade and winter spices with zesty cacao

**Dalmore 15 year old 40% abv** £11.50  
Rich and classic with vanilla, ginger and apples

**Dalmore 15 year old 43% abv** £21.70  
Full-bodied with chocolate raisins, citrus, rich coffee and nutmeg

**Fettercairn Fior 42% abv** £6.50  
Handsome mix of trifle, marzipan and pineapple

**Glenfiddich 12 year old 40% abv** £6.95  
Classically light and smooth with orchard fruits, vanilla and oak

**Glenfiddich 15 year old 40% abv** £7  
Salty and nutty alongside orange and honey

**Glenfiddich 18 year old 40% abv** £9.95  
Grassy malt with a touch of oak surrounded by complex fruit and sugar

**Glenfiddich IPA 43% abv** £6.30  
A non-aged mature statement presents a unique citrus notes with a gentle hoppy tang

## Tobermory un-peated & Ledaig peated

**Tobermory 12 year old 46.3% abv** £7.50  
Sweet citrus, with warm caramel and rich vanilla

**Tobermory 12 year old 62.1%** £15  
Pedro Ximinez cask finish, dark chocolate, orange, jam, raisin finished for 11 months.

**Tobermory 11 year old 58.3% abv** £15  
Bourbon barrel, zesty and vibrant, complex and woody with a touch of honey

**Tobermory 17 year old 54.2% abv** £15  
Dessert whisky as it has aged 13 years in ex-bourbon and 4 years in Maderia cask. Notes of dark fruits, caramel and burnt toffee.

**Tobermory 20 year old 46.3% abv** £35  
Celebrating 222 years of distilling. Sherry Oloroso cask finish. Dark black and red fruits, with a touch of cinnamon and oak

**Tobermory 23 Oloroso 46.3% abv** £45  
Strong sherry influence with a subtle walnut and salt undercurrent

**Tobermory 1995 52.7% abv** £45  
Manzanilla finish. Sweet and fruity with floral and gingerbread notes and a hint of coffee and chocolate

**Ledaig 10 year old 46.3% abv** £7.50  
Tantalisingly sweet, medicinal flavours infused with enticing sparks of spicy pepper and dried fruit with rich peaty smoke and a velvety vanilla and malty creaminess. (38-40PPM)

**Ledaig 9 year old 56.8% abv** £12.50  
Fully matured bordeaux red wine cask. Burning heather and pine cones. Grape skins and melons, wood smoked meats

**Ledaig 13 year old 53.8% abv** £18  
A marriage between a red wine cask and an oloroso sherry for 13 years. A wave of smoke gives way to reveal chocolate covered strawberries, stewed plums, vanilla and nutmeg, with a salty sea spray.

**Ledaig 18 year old 46.3% abv** £18  
Malt of the Year 2023 awarded by the whisky exchange. Aged 16 years ex bourbon offers vanilla and honey. Finished in an oloroso cask for 22 months. Its the perfect combination of peat and sweet.

**Ledaig 12 year old 57.5% abv** £15  
Finished for 18 months in an Amarone red wine cask. smoky yet sweet and nutty.

**Ledaig 2012 Bourbon Barrel 58.3% abv** £19.95  
Pear and apple boiled fruit sweets with baked Bramley apple. Add some water and the more savoury notes of Tobermory are present. A hint of saltiness and maybe some pitted olives.

**Ledaig Sinclair Series 46.3% abv** £8.50  
A non aged mature statement in honour of the gentleman who first established the distillery in 1798. This is a rioja finish, on the palate a sweet nuttiness, followed by fresh cut grass.

## Islay

**Ardbeg 10 year old 46% abv** £6.50  
Sweet vanilla with a contrast of lemon, lime and familiar smoke

**Bowmore 12 year old 40% abv** £6  
Puffs of peat and honey touched by lemon zest

**Bowmore No.1 40% abv** £7.50  
Sweet oats, seaside citrus and soft touches of smoke

**Bruichladdich islay barley 50% abv** £6.50  
Floral sweetness followed by almond walnut and barley

**Bruichladdich Classic Laddie 50% abv** £6.50  
Harmony of sweet oak and barley, green fruits and sugar

**Bruichladdich Port Charlotte 50% abv** £10.55  
Heavy oak and burning coal, peaty, earthy and green

**Bunnahabain 12 year old 46.3% abv** £5.70  
Sister distillery to Tobermory this 12 year old offers a light, fruity and nutty, with hints of vanilla, caramel and sea salt

**Bunnahabain Toiteach a dha 46.3% abv** £7.40  
Sea salt and chippers, with dark chocolate and sherry

**Bunnahabain 18 year old 46.3% abv** £16.80  
Dense rich sherry, with a light oaky note, and grassy tones

**Caol Ila 12 year old 43% abv** £6.55  
Honey pumpkin pie and a cloud of peat smoke and wood

**Lagavulin 16 year old 43% abv** £11.50  
Peaty dry oak, with a sweetness from cherries and vanilla

**Laphroig Select 40% abv** £4.10  
Malty, peaty and citrusy, with a slight welcome bitterness

**Laphroaig Quarter Cask 48% abv** £6.25  
Peaty dry oak, with a sweetness from cherries and vanilla

**Laphroig 10 year old 40% abv** £8.20  
Bold and smoky with a hint of seaweed sweetness

**Octomore Series 5 64% abv** £27  
The peatest whisky we have to offer. The Octomore comes in at 258ppm (phenols parts per million.) a medium peat is ledaig. Sweet yet spicy and is smothering in the mouth.
