Re: Request for a Presentation regarding the Orange County Power Authority

On December 10, 2019, the Irvine City Council gave final approval to establish the Orange County Power Authority (OCPA) — a joint powers authority to provide clean, renewable energy for our City (and other participating municipalities), and to help us achieve our stated climate-action goals for carbon reduction. Irvine is the lead municipality in the OCPA, which now also includes the cities of Huntington Beach, Fullerton, and Buena Park.

The City of Irvine committed to funding the organization and launch of the Orange County Power Authority.

I take this opportunity to request that our City staff and OCPA officials provide a Presentation — an OCPA progress report — for the benefit of the City Council and the entire Irvine community. I am officially requesting a “second” so that this matter may be placed on the City Council agenda for our meeting of October 12 or October 26.
