

Terms & Conditions

General Information:

- a. The Calligraphy Collective 2024 (hereinafter referred to as "the Event") is a calligraphy-focused event organised by [Organiser Name].
- b. By purchasing a ticket or attending the Event, the attendee (hereinafter referred to as "the Attendee") agrees to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

Agenda:

- a. The Event agenda is subject to change without notice at the discretion of the organisers.
- b. The organisers reserve the right to modify, cancel, or reschedule any part of the Event, including sessions, workshops, speakers, or activities, without prior notice to the Attendee.
- c. The organisers will make reasonable efforts to inform Attendees about any significant changes to the Event agenda via the official event website or email communication.

Ticket Purchase and Cancellation:

- a. Attendees may purchase tickets for the Event through the designated ticketing platform.
- b. All ticket sales are final, and no refunds or exchanges will be issued, except as provided in Clause 4 (Event Cancellation or Postponement).
- c. The Attendee is responsible for providing accurate information during the ticket purchase process, including contact details.

Event Cancellation or Postponement:

- a. In the event that the organisers cancel the Event, the Attendee may be eligible for a refund, subject to the organiser's discretion.

- c. The organisers will not be responsible for any costs incurred by the Attendee due to the Event cancellation or postponement, such as travel or accommodation expenses.

Attendee Conduct:

a. The Attendee is expected to behave in a respectful and appropriate manner throughout the Event.

- b. Any disruptive, offensive, or illegal behaviour by the Attendee may result in immediate expulsion from the Event without refund.
- c. The Attendee is responsible for any damages caused to the Event venue, equipment, or materials due to their negligence or misconduct.

Intellectual Property:

- a. The organisers and/or their partners may record or photograph the Event for promotional or documentation purposes.
- b. By attending the Event, the Attendee grants the organisers the right to use their likeness, image, or voice in any promotional materials without compensation.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

- a. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.
- b. Any disputes arising from or related to the Event or these Terms and Conditions shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.

Severability:

a. If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is found to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable.
