





Outdoor masterworks from a woman with landscape design in her roots

"My father created the most beautiful backyards for me to play in as a child, and we had many because we moved frequently," says Crawford, now a prominent landscape designer based in North County San Diego. FAMILY-FRIENDLY WHILE REMAINING ELEVATED and chic, this home's landscape is modern and Mediterranean. A delightful space for entertaining, it includes many desired exterior features that enhance the Southern California lifestyle.

Branch Out achieved the front landscape's old-world charm by combining fieldgrown olive trees with modern plant touches. An interior courtyard beckons with a custom bubbling fountain made from limestone and an ivory-colored fireplace. The backyard has many spaces to gather and play, including a large kitchen, pool, outdoor shower, firepit, TV lounge, sandpit and children's playhouse. THE THEFT

THIS PROJECT'S MODERN DESIGN is simultaneously chic and casual. The garden palette is restrained to allow the home's architecture to shine, while creating privacy, shade and a space for children and dogs to play.

Ofive trees help cool the entrance where a large glass pivot-door beckons guests inside. An architecturally shaped Dracaena marginata pops thru the roof opening to be enjoyed again from the upper balcony. In the backyard, there's a small grass area for children and dogs to play outdoors. An elevated dining space has a second, lower concrete counter paired with fun and durable stools for children to enjoy. A planter box for kitchen herbs and veggies, a dog run and a deck for lounging and resting complete this enviable exterior space.
