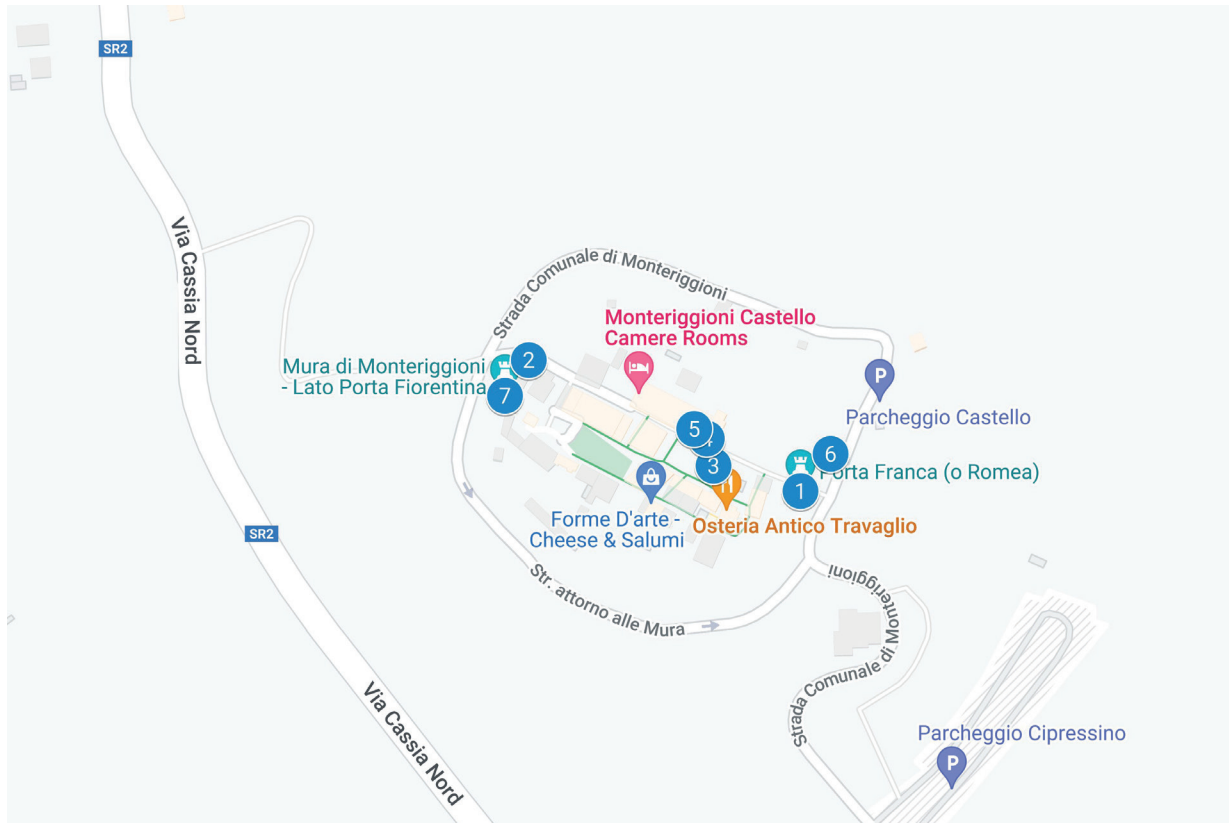


## Monteriggioni: one of Italy's best-preserved medieval towns



Monteriggioni's history dates back to 1213. It was strategically built by the Siense as a defensive fortification during the conflicts between Siena and Florence. The medieval city wall and majestic, well-preserved defense towers still characterize Monteriggioni's townscape today.
