SCHEDULE

GCLI features a hybrid mix of teaching and learning opportunities. The next Institute will take place throughout January through March 2023. This will include: about four virtual weeks from January through February with a time commitment of about 5 hours per week; one virtual week in February with a time commitment of about 8 hours total (spread across the week in a series of daily 60-90 minute webinars); and one in-person week in March (March 5-8 in Knoxville, Tennessee). The in-person portion is required for accepted applicants.

CURRICULUM AND COST

The focus areas of the Green Communities Leadership Institute are: Expanding Personal Leadership Influence and Competencies, Increasing Organizational Leadership Impact, and Advancing Community Leadership Capacity. Throughout these focus areas, participants will gain confidence in mastering the core competencies of leadership, navigating crucial conversations and conflict, fostering and managing organizational change, cultivating a continuous learning leadership mindset, and much more. Tuition for the Institute is \$1,800, which includes all instruction and materials, plus most meals at the on-site location sessions in Knoxville, Tennessee. Participants can anticipate additional costs for transportation and some meals for the in-person sessions.



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
