Dangerous Dogs Condition

We are glad to still be able to let our fields to dogs which are listed under the dangerous dogs rules (XL Bullies etc), however there are some things which our insurers have asked for.



If your dog is listed under the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991 or the Control of Dogs (Scotland) Act 2010) or the Dangerous Dogs (Northern Ireland) Order 1991, or any replacement legislation:

The dog must be registered or specifically exempted from the applicable legislation and a copy of the exemption order or certificate needs to be emailed to, and retained by us. A copy of the owner's public liability insurance certificate for the dog needs to be emailed to, and retained by us. This must be repeated every time you get a new insurance certificate. If it has expired you are not allowed to use these fields.

Both of these **must** be emailed to dogsfields@molesfarm.co.uk

- The dog handler ratio needs to 1:1 with their handler at all times unless with other dogs from the same household
- The dog is kept on a lead and muzzled until the gate is closed and locked when entering the exercise field
- The dog is put back on a lead and muzzled before opening the locked gate to leave the exercise field
- Only dogs from one household can use the exercise field at any one time.
