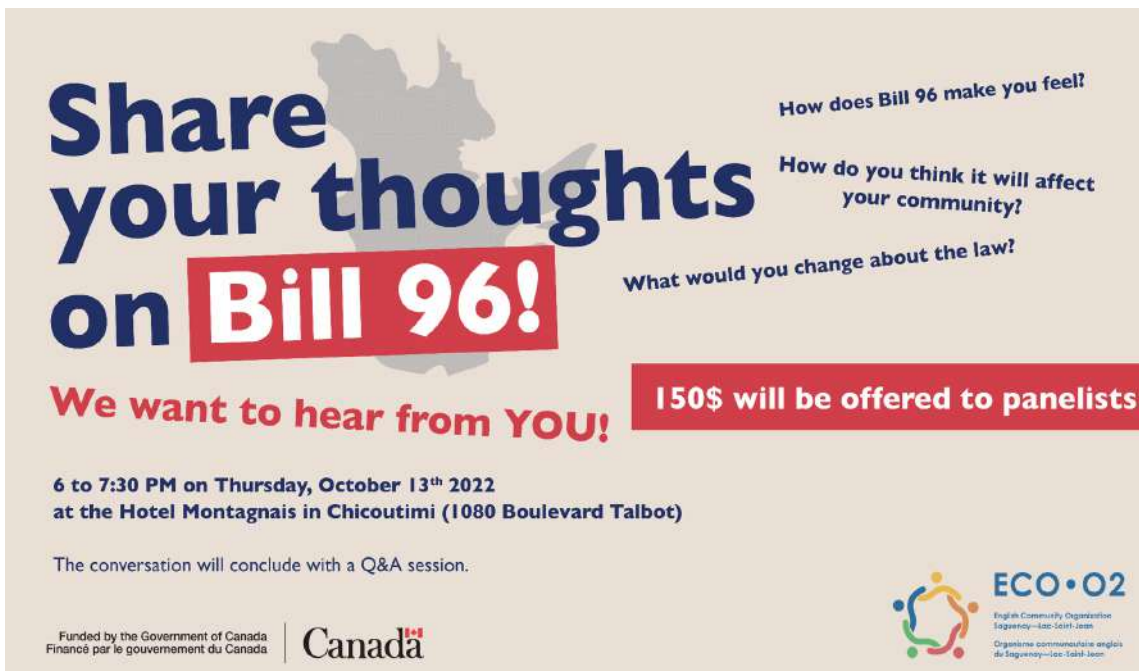

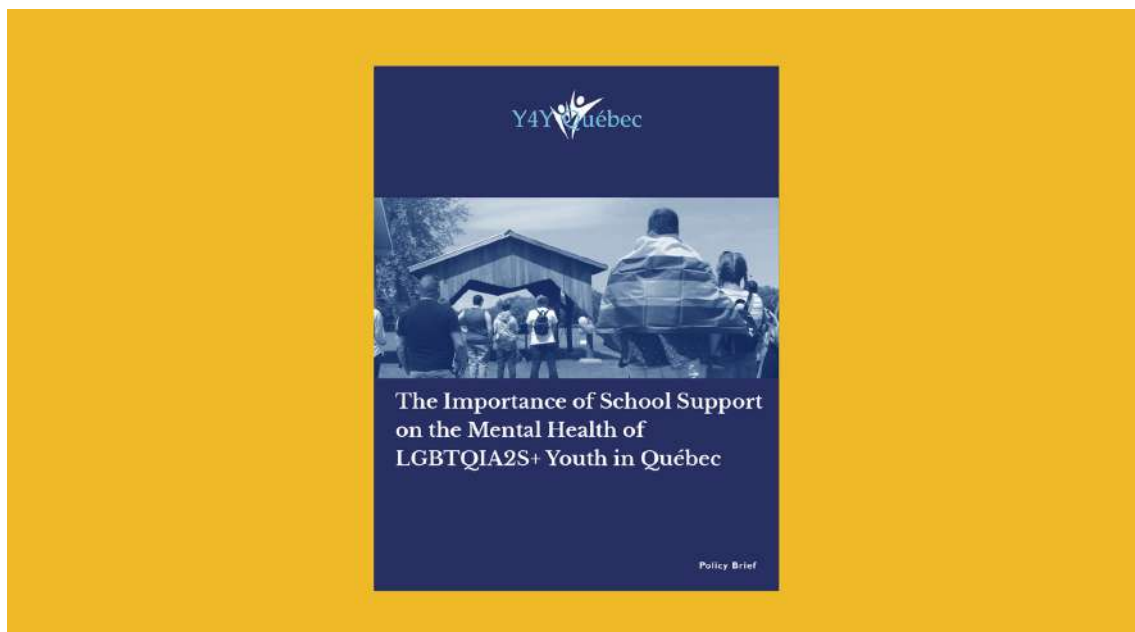

Although Québec passed laws prohibiting discrimination based on gender identity, discriminatory comments and feelings of isolation among LGBTQIA2S+ youth in high schools are still rampant. This leads queer youth to report significantly poorer mental health conditions than their cisgender heterosexual counterparts. So, how does school support affect the mental health of LGBTQIA2S+ youth across Québec? What can schools do? And what can the Québec government do?
