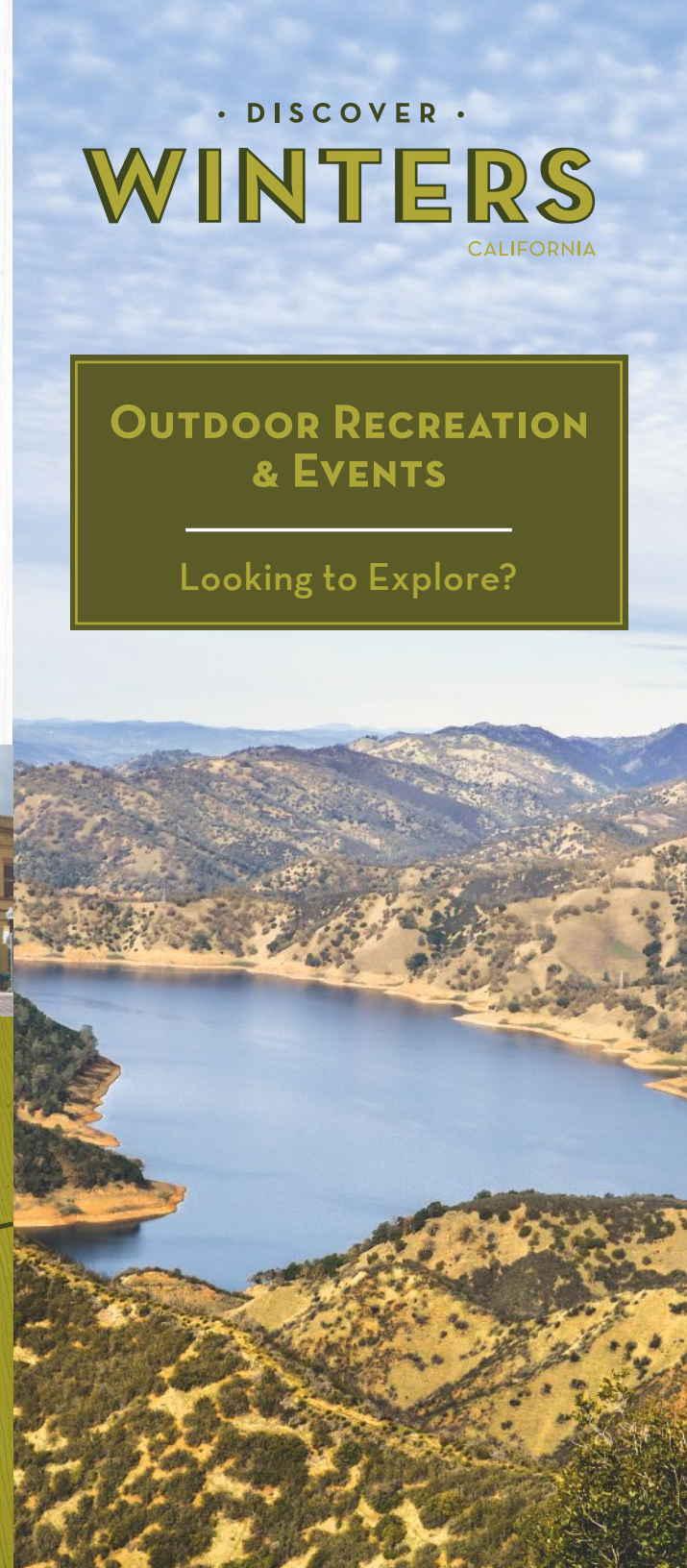

WINTERS BRINGS IN PLENTY OF OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES FOR THOSE WHO ARE ADVENTUROUS. Let your mind take you to an area that promotes both tranquility and health. Explore what nature provides all around us here in Winters.

LAKE SOLANO RECREATION

Take the family to Lake Solano because it has everything for a fun trip – camping, fishing, horseshoe pits, sand volleyball courts, paddleboats and canoe rentals. Go for the day or camp for a week and be sure to take some time to visit Winters. Solano County operates a campground with 83 campsites, of which 36 have water and electric hookups. There are restrooms with flush toilets, sinks and hot showers. The day use area has picnic sites, group picnic facilities, a free boat launch for non-powered vessels, parking, restrooms and a public telephone.

Fishing licenses and tackle are available in Winters at Berryessa Sporting Goods.

Markley Cove Resort is both a convenient and a historical location for boaters and recreational enthusiasts. Since its inception in 1959, thousands of visitors have come to this small friendly marina located on the southern shores of beautiful Lake Berryessa. Lake Berryessa, known to locals as California's "best kept secret" offers YEAR AROUND recreational opportunities. Twenty three miles long, the lake has approximately 165 miles of oak-covered shoreline. The smog free climate is wonderful and the lake is convenient to both the Sacramento valley and the Bay area. Markley Cove itself is centrally located between the quaint little town of Winters, CA and the spectacular Napa valley.
