


WHO'S IN THE RACE

ENDORSEMENTS:

Equality & Reproductive Rights:

- Authored anti-hate legislation as a state Senator, and will continue to stand up for marginalized communities in Congress
- Authored Prop 1 which now guarantees Californians access to abortion and contraception

Gun Safety:

- Earned an "F" Rating from the NRA for leadership on gun violence prevention, including authoring the first-in-the-nation law that ended gun shows on state properties

Environment:

- Authored legislation to end offshore drilling and to decarbonize the economy
- Also authored the first in the nation bill to enact the "30 by 30" goals to protect 30% of our open spaces by 2030

Affordable Housing and Homelessness:

- Supports increasing funding for affordable housing and easing barriers lower-income households face accessing housing

ENDORSEMENTS:

Mike Johnson, Speaker of the House

Accountability:

- Admitted to 9 violations of California's Political Reform Act and was forced to pay a \$47,900 penalty because of his connection to an election-rigging scheme
- Connected to *another* scandal where 600 voters had their party registration changed without their knowledge, which led to 12 arrests

Access to Health Care:

- Supported repeal of the Affordable Care Act. This would have caused 52,300 Orange County residents to lose their health insurance and weakened protections for people with pre-existing conditions
- Has **still** made no statement on the need to protect abortion rights at a federal level since the overturn of Roe v. Wade

Quiet on Important Issues:

- Declined to acknowledge Joe Biden as the winner of the 2020 election
- Declined to answer how he would vote on the legality of gay marriage if it ever comes back before Congress

WHY IT MATTERS

This Race is Close but Winnable:

- The Cook Political Report ranks this race as "lean Democrat", In 2022, Baugh lost by just 3 points
- President Biden won in this district by 11 points in 2020, and this year's presidential election is expected to boost Democratic turnout

Baugh is too Extreme for the District:

- Baugh is a close ally of far-right Republican Speaker of the House, Mike Johnson
- Baugh is closely tied to anti-LGBTQ religious extremists, who fund his campaign
