Equality & Reproductive Rights:

- Supporter of the Women's Health Protection Act, which would codify Roe v. Wade
- Supports passage of the Equality Act, which would prohibit discrimination based on sexual orientation and gender identity

Health Care

- Will enhance legal protections for Americans with pre-existing conditions. and work to establish a baseline of coverage for all Americans
- Will work to increase transparency in health care and decrease insurance premiums

Gun Safety:

- Aligns with 90% of Americans in supporting background checks, red flag laws, and banning high-capacity magazines

The Environment:

- Recognizes the danger climate change poses
- Supports investments in clean energy and energy efficiency programs
- Sees opportunity for clean-tech businesses and a bolstered economy in Riverside County

LGBTQ+ Rights:

- Has one of the worst anti-LGBTQ voting records in the House
- Supported appropriations bill that defunded LGBTQ+ centers

Reproductive Rights:

- Opposed the Women's Health Protection Act, which would codify Roe v. Wade
- Supported a bill that removed leave and travel reimbursements for US troops that have to travel to another state for reproductive health care services

Health Care:

- Voted against the Inflation Reduction Act, which caps prescription drug costs for Medicare, including capping the cost of insulin to \$35/month
- Opposed to the Affordable Care Act, which provides care to millions of Californians annually

Gun Safety:

- Voted against the Protecting our Kids Act and the bipartisan background check bill
- Received more NRA campaign money than any other California Congressman from 1998 to 2016

WHY IT MATTERS

This Race is Close but Winnable:

- In 2022, newcomer Rollins lost to Calvert in 2022 by about 11,000 votes
- This year, Rollins has outstanding fundraising and better name recognition that can help him close the gap and win in 2024

MAGA Republican:

- Calvert is an extremist who voted against certifying the 2020 election results, even after the deadly January 6th insurrection
- When Trump was in office, Calvert voted in accordance with him **96.8%** of the time
