Healthcare & Reproductive Justice:

- As a state legislator, authored legislation that doubled operating hours for health clinics, allowing greater access to health care for Valley residents
- Supported legislation that prohibits California from dictating individuals' reproductive decisions over birth, birth control, and abortion
- Secured coverage of continuous glucose monitors under Medi-Cal

Economy & Environment:

- Procured \$2.75 billion for water storage funding
- Supported expanding grant programs to reduce college debt
- Passed legislation increasing tax credits for small businesses

Education:

- Secured more \$220 million to build medical education building at UC Merced, which enrolled its first class of future doctors in 2023
- Secured \$500,000 for after-school programs at Stanislaus and Merced Boys & Girls Clubs
- Restored funding for FFA chapters serving 83,000 high school students

MAGA Extremist

- Supported Trump-endorsed Jim Jordan and Mike Johnson for Speaker of the House
- Voted in accordance with Marjorie Taylor Greene 81% of the time

Health Care

- Voted against Inflation Reduction Act, which caps prescription drug costs for Medicare, including capping the cost of insulin to \$35/month
- Blocked the consideration of the Women's Health Protection Act, which would protect reproductive healthcare, like abortion, nationwide

Economy:

- Supported cuts to law enforcement, education, Social Security access, and small businesses in the failed, Republican-led Spending Reduction Bill
- Helped pass Republican-led legislation that is set to increase the deficit by \$114 billion over the next decade and makes it easier for the ultra wealthy to evade paying their fair share of taxes
- Endorsed the Republican Default Bill, which would have put funding for Medicare, veteran services, and supplemental food assistance programs at risk

WHY IT MATTERS

This Race is Close but Winnable:

- Roll Call ranked John Duarte as the #5 most vulnerable House member in the US
- John Duarte beat Adam Gray in 2022 by less than 600 votes
- Gray's campaign has gotten an early start this cycle and is poised to close the gap in 2024 with enough Democratic turn out.
- Biden won this district by 10 points in 2020
