Jacky Rosen (D)

Senator Jacky Rosen has been serving in her position since 2018 and is seeking re-election in 2024. She is the second woman to serve Nevada in the US Senate. Prior to being elected as Senator, Rosen served for two years in the US House of Representatives.

ON THE ISSUES

Economy

- Supported the Inflation Reduction Act, which has helped create good paying jobs in Nevada and lowered the cost of prescription medications, like insulin
- Opposes Republican-backed tax cuts for billionaires and corporations

Education

- Introduced the bipartisan Building Blocks of STEM Act, which expands STEM education initiatives and provides research grants to increase young girls' participation
- Supports better funding for public schools and higher pay for teachers

Equality

- Committed to protecting women's health care rights, like the right to abortion
- Secured \$1.5 million in funding to expand high-speed internet for Nevada Tribes
- Introduced the Freedom to Vote Act which would protect voting rights and strengthen campaign finance laws

Environment

- Secured more than \$9 billion in investments in Nevada wind, solar, and geothermal energy through the Inflation Reduction Act
- Acquired grant funding to help Nevada Tribes combat climate change

WHY IT MATTERS

Bipartisan Rating

- Senator Rosen has been recognized as one of the top 10 most bipartisan members in the Senate
- More than 90% of Senator Rosen's introduced legislation is bipartisan

NV is Key to a Senate Democratic Majority

- Nevada is a Presidential swing state, Senator Rosen won in 2018 by about 50,000 votes
- We must mobilize Democrats and Democrat-leaning independents to ensure her victory again in 2024
