


Pennsylvania Senate

ON THE ISSUES

Gun Violence Prevention

- Sponsored the Disarm Hate Act, which would prevent anyone convicted of a hate crime from purchasing a firearm
- Supports common sense gun safety measures, like universal background checks

Equality

- Voted in support of the Women's Health Protection Act, which would protect the right to abortion care federally
- Introduced the Visitable Inclusive Tax Credit for Accessible Living (VITAL) Act, which would increase investment in developing affordable housing and ensure that units meet accessibility standards
- Committed to supporting Pennsylvanians with disabilities and ensuring access to quality education, health care and employment

Health Care:

- Sponsored the Medicaid for Every Child Act, which would make all children eligible for Medicare from birth to age 19
- Has worked to defend the Affordable Care Act, protect Medicare, and lower out-of-pocket health care costs
- Voted in support of the Inflation Reduction Act, which capped insulin costs at \$35

Economy:

- Co-sponsored the Wage Theft Prevention and Wage Recovery Act, which would take steps to stop wage theft and help with the recovery of wages stolen from workers
- Opposes Republican-backed tax cuts for the ultra-wealthy, and is committed to creating tax policies that help rebuild the middle class
