Access to Healthcare:

- Voted against capping insulin co-pays at \$35
- Voted against the Build Back Better Act, which allows Medicare to negotiate lower prescription drug prices and cap out-of-pocket drug costs for seniors
- Co-sponsored Life at Conception Act which is a national abortion ban

Environmental Issues:

- Steel's top campaign contributor is oil giant BP Industries, which has donated more than \$25K to her 2024 campaign
- Voted against the Government Funding and Delivering Emergency Assistance Act, which allocated \$28.6 billion in disaster relief funding, including millions to assist those affected by wildfires and drought in California

Gun Safety:

- Opposed the Assault Weapons Ban of 2022 and the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act, both of which take common sense steps towards improving gun safety, like increased background checks on purchasers under 21

WHY IT MATTERS

This Race is Key to a Winning House Majority:

- The Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee (DCCC) has listed CA-45 as one of the key Districts in Play for the 2024 cycle to win back House Majority

Steel is Too Extreme for the District:

- Biden won this district in 2020 by 11 points, and while Trump was in office Steel voted in accordance with him 100% of the time, including against impeaching Trump
