

Loudoun Grant Requests



As part of a community we love and are proud to call home, we try to find ways to make Loudoun County better. Each year, the credit union sets aside funds to offer grants to local not-for-profit organizations within Loudoun County.

This year, LCU will offer grants to three (3) local non-profit organizations in the amount of \$3,000 each.

A **two-page** typed letter must be submitted in order to be considered for one of the grants. The letter should:

- Briefly describe the organization
- Describe how the organization serves Loudoun County residents
- Detail how the grant would be used

Note: Letters longer than two pages or that do not show how the money will be used, will not be considered. Organizations that win the award will be expected to show proof of their not-for-profit status. Grant recipients are also expected to provide a report of how the money was used within one year of receiving the grant.

All request letters become property of the LCU Grant Committee, and each request will be evaluated individually. All decisions will be based solely upon the grant committee members' interpretation of which proposal will best serve the residents of Loudoun County. All decisions are final.
