

2022 CGP Reissuance Review: Now Available for QSDs and QSPs

With the adoption of the 2022 Construction General Permit (CGP), new requirements are set to become effective on September 1, 2023. To provide training on key components of the new requirements, Qualified SWPPP Developers (QSDs) and Qualified SWPPP Practitioners (QSPs) are required to complete the 2022 CGP Reissuance Review (Reissuance Review).

The Reissuance Review includes just under four hours of video modules with corresponding quizzes. The Office of Water Programs (OWP) QSD and QSP Public Lookup Tool will identify QSDs/QSPs that have completed the Reissuance Review as "2022 GGP Trained."

Timeline for completing the Reissuance Review:

- Existing QSDs/QSPs (certified through CASQA): To encourage QSDs/QSPs to have the most current knowledge related to the 2022 CGP, it is recommended that you complete the 2022 CGP Reissuance Review as soon as possible. However, you must complete the review process in order to obtain or renew your QSD or QSP certification.
- Self-Certifying QSDs: Must be completed by September 1, 2024.
- Candidate QSDs/QSPs: Must be completed to obtain certification.

Reissuance Review Process

Existing QSDs and QSPs certified through CASQA

- 1. Log in to your existing OWP account.
- 2. Navigate to the "CGP QSD and QSP" tab.
- Navigate to the yellow box with the exclamation mark and select the "2022 CGP Reissuance Review" button. [Note: If it is within 90 days of your certification expiration date, you may also use the "Renewals" section.]
- Clicking the 2022 CGP Reissuance Review button will reroute you to OWP's e-learning website, where you
 will see another login page. Use your OWP website login username and password to access the OWP elearning site.
- 5. Watch each of the five modules and pass the corresponding quizzes. Passing rates will be displayed on the screen as you complete the exams.
- 6. Completion of the final quiz will allow the "Submit all and finish" button to be selected to complete the 2022 Reissuance Review process. [Note: Successful completion of quizzes is required to complete the process.]

- 7. If applicable, pay any renewal fees. If you are completing this step prior to renewing your certification, payment of fees is not necessary.
- 8. Completing the 2022 CGP Reissuance Review will provide the individual with a 'Yes' on the OWP Public Lookup tool in the column "CGP 2022 Trained." Additionally, QSDs will be provided with a 'Yes' in the 2022 CGP Trained column of the SMARTS QSD Search Screen.

Note: QSDs and QSPs do not need to wait for certification renewal to complete the Reissuance Review. It is recommended that you complete the Reissuance Review as soon as possible to show you have completed training under the 2022 CGP.

Candidate QSDs and QSPs

- 1. Successfully complete the QSD or QSP State Approved Training Class (in-person or virtual).
- 2. Create an OWP account and log in.
- 3. Navigate to the "CGP QSD and QSP" tab.
- 4. Navigate to the blue "Exam" box and select.
- 5. Follow the steps listed in the new tab.

Step 1 - Specify your underlying certificate.

Step 2 - Specify your training details.

Step 3 - Access CGP Review Issues 1 through 5 and complete a review of each document.

Step 4 - Pay your registration fee for either the QSD or QSP depending on which exams you will be taking.

Step 5 - Take the 2009 QSP Permit exam. If applicable, also take the 2009 QSD Permit exam. Results will be emailed to the candidate.

Step 6 - Access the 2022 CGP Reissuance Review. Watch each of the five modules and pass the corresponding quizzes. Passing rates will be displayed on the screen as you complete the quizzes.

- 6. Completion of the final quiz will allow the "Submit all and finish" button to be selected to complete the 2022 Reissuance Review process. [Note: Successful completion of quizzes is required to complete the process.]
- 7. Successful passing of all quizzes, coupled with an underlying qualifying certification and successful passing of the Permit exam, will result in the individual being issued the QSD or QSP certificate, as applicable.
- The new QSD or QSP will be visible in OWP's Public Lookup tool with a 'Yes' in the column "CGP 2022 Trained." Additionally, QSDs will be provided with a 'Yes' in the 2022 CGP Trained column of the SMARTS QSD Search Screen.

Self-Certifying QSDs

The following process will be available in August 2023:

- 1. Log in to SMARTS.
- 2. Navigate to the "Construction General Permit" tab.
- 3. Navigate to "CBPELSG QSD" tab.
- 4. Access the 2022 CGP Reissuance Review.
- 5. Watch each of the five modules.
- 6. Certify that the 2022 CGP Reissuance Review modules were accessed and completed.

- 7. Certify that the information is true, accurate, and complete.
- 8. Select "Submit."
- 9. The QSD will be provided with a 'Yes' in the 2022 CGP Trained column of the SMARTS QSD Search Screen.

Note: Self-certified QSDs do not need to complete the quiz portion of the 2022 CGP Reissuance Review.
