

# Questions for International Workers

## MISSIONS MOBILIZATION

Whether you are just trying to get to know an international worker or are looking for things to ask in an interview, these questions are great ones to get you started!

### QUESTIONS

- Tell us about yourself and your immediate family (spouse, kids, pets, etc.).
- How long have you been a missionary where you currently are and in general?
- How did God call you into ministry? Tell us your story and please include details.
- If you didn't answer this already, how did God bring you to where you're currently serving?
- What do you love most about the work you're doing? What energizes and excites you about it? Why?
- What are the biggest challenges you face day to day and why?
- What's a really amazing "God-story" you can share from your ministry? Think of it as the moment(s) that makes you realize "This is why I'm doing what I'm doing!"
- What's the hardest situation you've experienced in your ministry work and why?
- What have you accomplished so far that you're really proud of and excited about?
- What are you trusting God to do still in your ministry work?
- From a big-picture, long-term perspective, how can we be praying for you and your work?
- If you're overseas, what things or people do you miss most about life in the U.S.?
- How often do you come home and for how long at a time?
- When you do come home, what are some ways we could love you well? Think of things you might need and people you'd like to meet.
- What's your favorite local food where you're serving? Do you have a favorite local recipe you could share?
- What else should our congregation know about you and your work that we haven't asked about?
