PLAYER DEVELOPMENT

Created individualized plans via film breakdown and synergy analytics. Specialized in coaching the post players by helping Chris Burgess teach offensive & defensive technique.

STAFF MEETINGS

Discussed practice plans, reviewed games, coordinated recruiting efforts and visits, examined player development, considered player health (physical, mental, & emotional), and talked about booster and alumni relations.
