

Inspired by the \$2MM impact of the local Women's only group, Impact 100, the new "100 Donors" nonprofit is tapping into the unrealized potential of Westchester "men" to help further address critical local unmet needs and to create an organization capable of generating annual transformative results

WESTCHESTER COUNTY, NY - 100 Donors (<u>100donors.org</u>) Co-founder and Board President, David Ringler, CAP®, CRPC®, CPFA, announced today that 100 Donors, Inc, one of Westchester's newest 501c3 organizations, has made its inaugural grant of \$20,000 to Spectrum Designs Foundation. The grant was made possible by the 2021 founding members of this men's only collective giving organization.

"This is an important grant for a vital organization in our community that will have a transformational impact on our community over the coming years, Ringler said. "The good it will do is why we started this, and it's only just the beginning.

Spectrum Designs Foundation (SDF) is a nonprofit with a social mission: to create meaningful and inclusive employment opportunities for people on the Autism Spectrum. This transformative program addresses the unmet employment needs of Autistic Westchester residents. This project is directly aligned with 100 Donors' values of equality, community and diversity. Having opened their Westchester location in 2020, the grant with help build its organizational infrastructure in order to provide meaningful work and training opportunities for people with Autism in Westchester.

Patrick Bardsley, Co-Founder and CEO remarked, "It is a great honor to accept this inaugural grant from 100 Donors. We know there were many worthy applicants, so it is extra special to be recognized by the members of 100 Donors who believe so wholeheartedly in our community. The funds from this grant will be used towards building a more equitable workforce that dismantles barriers, dispels myths, and expands opportunities for people of all abilities. We thank 100 Donors for believing in our mission and for their incredible generosity."

David Ringler, commented on the origins of 100 Donors, "Too often men are outside the giving process. We came together to create 100 Donors to be a space where men can give a smaller amount and still feel the larger impact. We hope to become the beacon for other men in the community to step forward and give big together."

Ringler continued, "100 Donors is providing the men of Westchester with an understanding that collective giving works. We're so proud and thankful to the founding local members who have stepped up in our inaugural year, during this time of great uncertainty, trusting this vision and making an inaugural gift of over \$20,000 not just possible . . . and of today, a reality as well."
