ROADS - BACKGROUND

- Public requests for a safer crossing at village square
- Public requests to slow traffic
- Observation of numerous bumps and shunts
- Feedback from Community Action Plan
- Feedback from Living Well Locally study early this year



LIVING WELL LOCALLY

- Speeding cars are seen as a risk to safety
- There is a demand to prioritise pedestrian safety, with pedestrian crossings around the set of junctions in the centre of Drymen.
- Improved traffic calming measures to replace the existing ones (considered by some to be ineffective)
- Enforcement of parking rules, especially around SPAR



POTENTIAL SOLUTION

- Funding from Road Safety Trust for a pilot study
- Community to be involved in process and have their say
- If successful DCDT would seek funding to make permanent
- End result, slower traffic, more places to cross, more public space to improve look of village centre.
