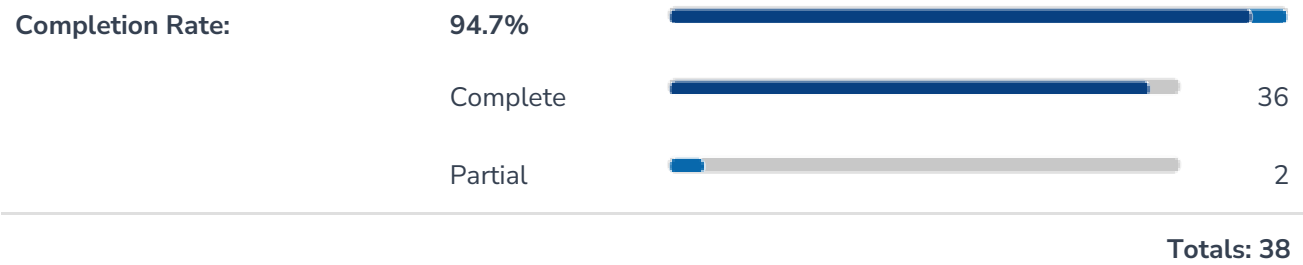
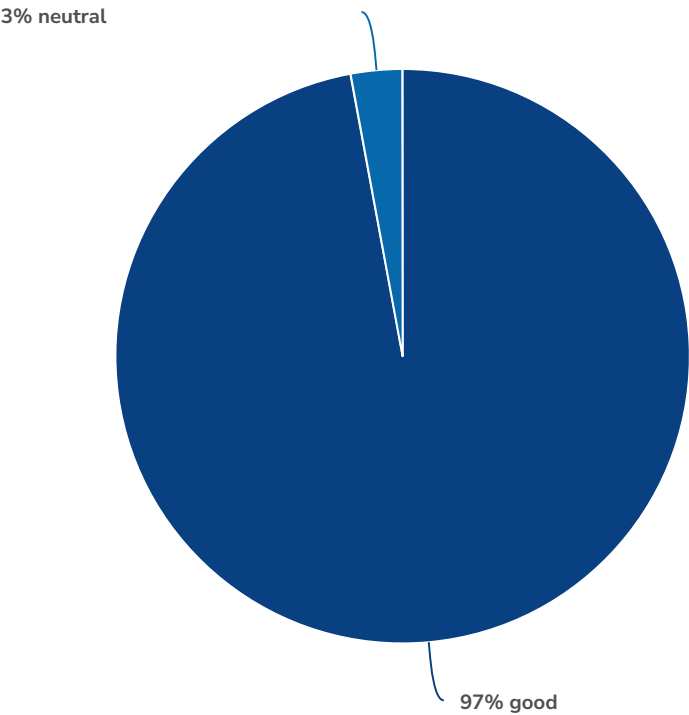

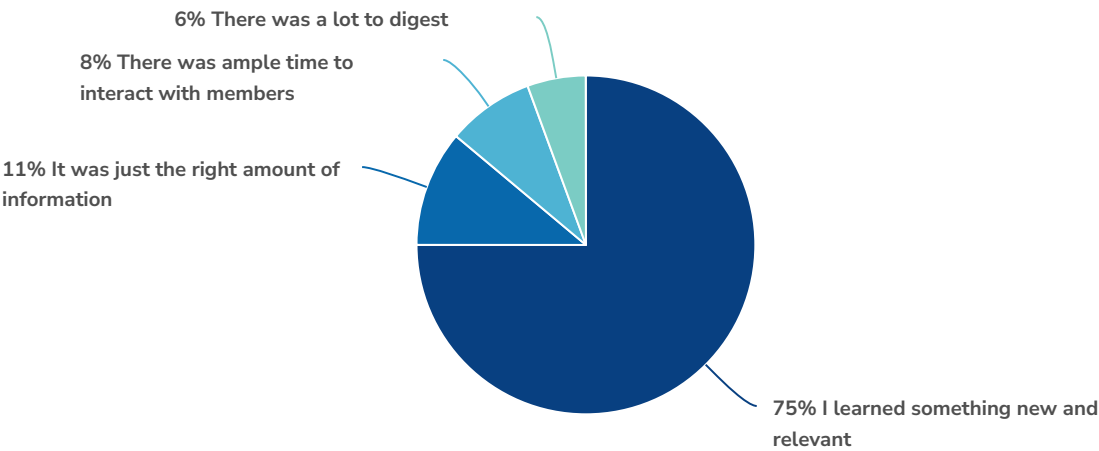
1. How would you rate your overall experience?

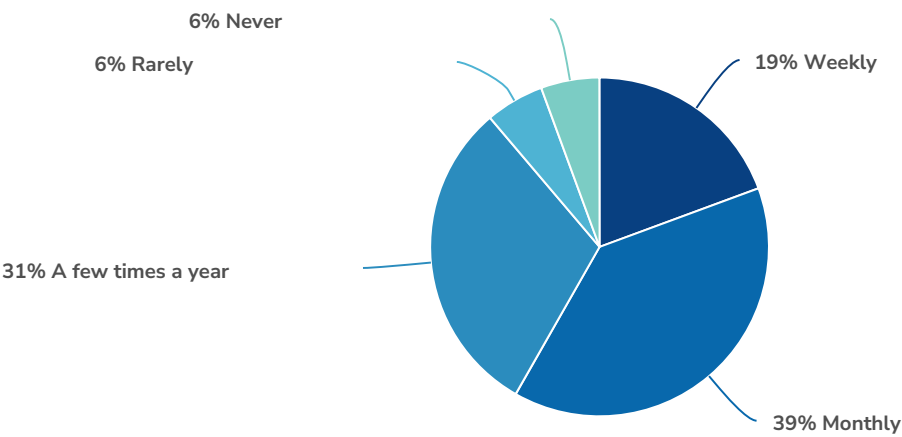
2. What are your thoughts about the workshop?

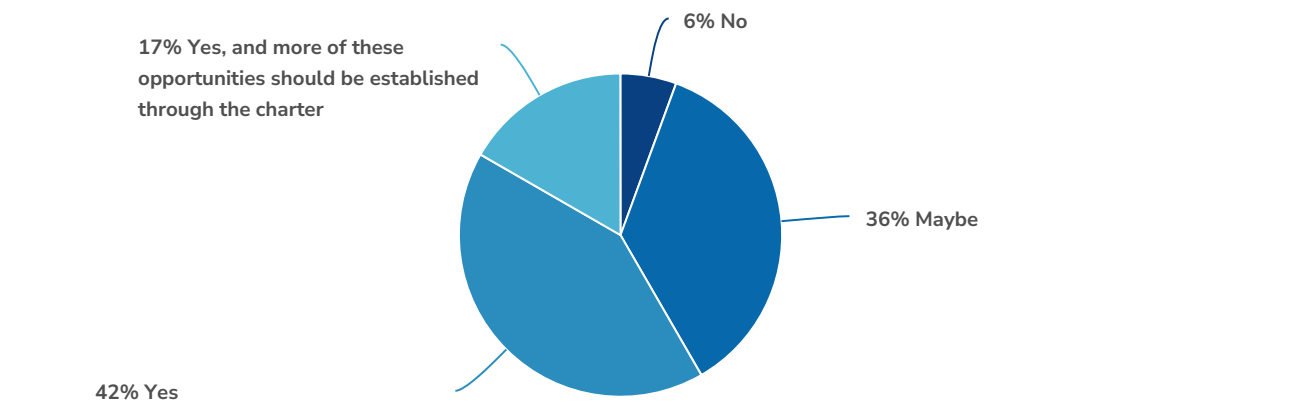

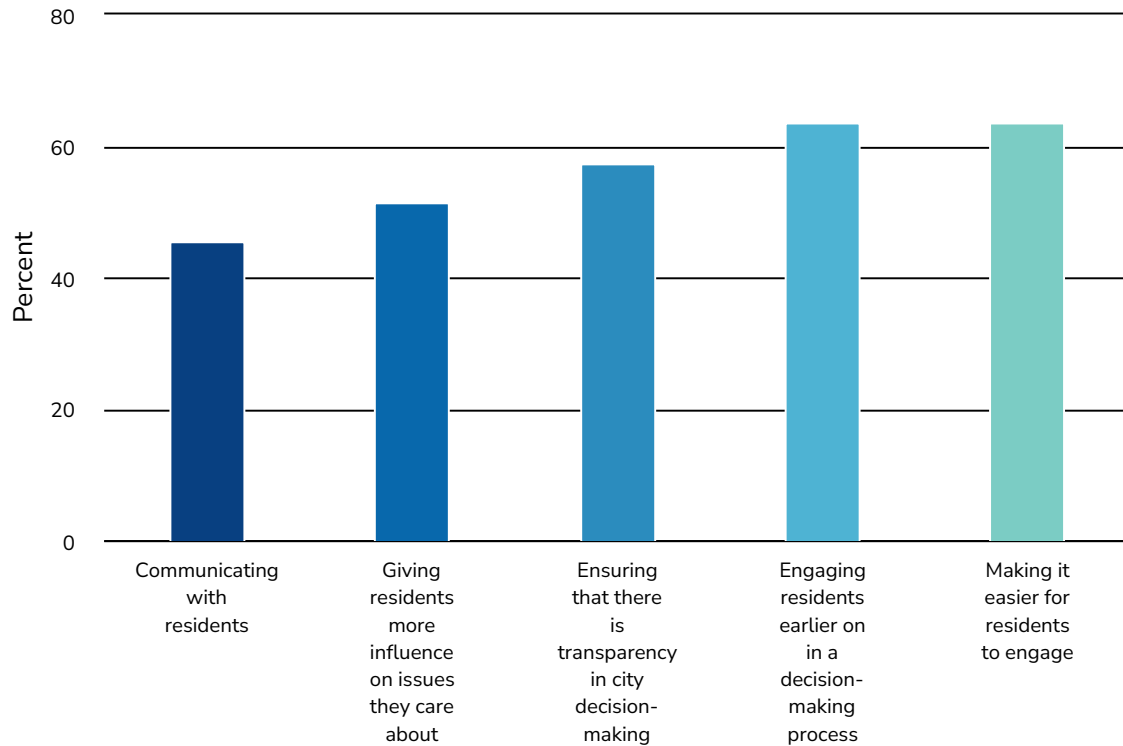
