Remind parents and caregivers not to skip or delay immunizations.

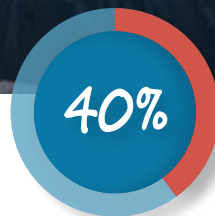
Vaccines will be required to allow for a return to in-person learning, and to resume sports activities.

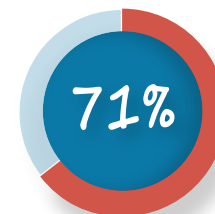
