The role of the Appropriate Body is to ensure that Early Career Teachers receive their statutory entitlements, are fairly and consistently assessed and receive a programme of support and training based on the Early Career Framework.

Once you have registered, you will receive an email from the Teaching School Hub with instructions on how to set up an account with us on ECT Manager - our Appropriate Body system which generates the termly progress reviews and formal assessments for you to complete for your ECTs. As soon as your account is authorised, you will be able to begin registering your ECTs, allowing us to claim them on the TRA System.
