# NON-MILTON STUDENT GUEST APPROVAL FORM DIRECTIONS

- Homecoming guests that do not currently attend High School must be approved IN ADVANCE. This includes Milton graduates.
- Once approved, you will receive and Approval Code to enter when purchasing a Non-Milton ticket.
- ONLY Milton students are allowed to purchase tickets, so be prepared to purchase the ticket for your guest.

## **STEP 1 - Complete MHS Student Info**

- Complete **Part 1: Milton Student Information** with required information about the MHS student who will be purchasing the Non-Milton ticket.
- Be sure to complete ALL sections including Parent Signature and Phone Number or the form will be returned to you without an approval code.

#### **STEP 2 - Complete Guest Student Info**

- Guest must be under 21 years of age
- Guest must be in 9th grade or above
- Guest must be accompanied by a Milton student
- Guest must follow FCS Code of Conduct
- Guest must present photo ID at the door
- Guest must be approved by MHS Administration
- Complete **Part 2 : Guest Student Information** with required information about the Non-Milton student guest.
- Be sure to complete ALL fields including the current grade, graduation year, or withdrawal year, as appropriate.

#### STEP 3 - Submit Form to Guest's Administrator

- Submit the form to the Non-Milton student's school administrator to complete Part 3. All high schools have a similar procedure, so the administrator will be familiar with the process.
- If the guest has graduated high school, a government issued photo ID must be submitted with the guest form.
- Return the completed and signed form to Mrs. Hatfield in RM 1276 no later than October 14, 2022.

#### STEP 4 - Check School Email for Approval Code

- Your Milton administrator will review the form and assign a unique Approval Code allowing the purchase of a Non-Milton Student Ticket within a week of returning the form.
- Approval forms will be emailed to the Milton Student Email. Please be sure to check your Milton Student Email.

### **STEP 5 - Order Ticket on GoFan with Approval Code**

- Order your Homecoming tickets through GoFan and enter the Approval Code when prompted for **Promo Code**.
