

Shadow a Student for the Day!

Student Shadow Days are available to all 7th - 11th grade students interested in spending the day on La Salle High School's campus to experience first-hand what it's like to be a student at La Salle! During the day, visitors are paired with a current student and will attend classes and eat lunch with our students. We warmly invite you to come and see what sets La Salle High School apart from other schools. Come and see for yourself what makes La Salle excellent in academics, athletics, activities, and social opportunities!

When can I visit? Shadow Day visits are scheduled on Mondays, Tuesdays or Fridays, October-May, beginning at 8:00 a.m. in the Main Office (Roy Hall) and ending at 3:00 p.m.

What should I wear? At La Salle, we do not require uniforms, but we do have a dress code designed to show respect for self and others. It is recommended that visitors adhere to the La Salle dress code, as outlined below.

- Collared shirt/blouse (polo-style works best) or a La Salle t-shirt.
- Pants, shorts, or skirts. Shorts and skirts must not be more than five inches above the middle of the knee.
- Comfortable, hard-soled shoes or athletic shoes (no slippers or flip flops)

What should I Bring?

- Light sweater or jacket that meets dress code-- temperatures in some class rooms may vary
- A book or other activity to keep busy, in case there is a quiz or test scheduled for a particular class
- If you bring a cell phone, please remember to be respectful on campus and either power off or keep it on silent mode throughout the day.
- Don't worry about bringing a lunch—you are our guest, lunch will be provided for all visiting students!

Please note, Student Shadow Days are dependent on the availability of the prospective student and the La Salle High School calendar. We ask for at least five days' notice prior to securing a Shadow Day visit.
