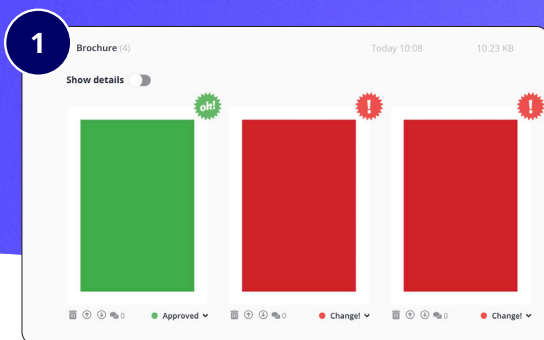


Automatic update of multi-page PDFs

Upload new versions in the tab and leave the remaining work to the technology. ProoferHive keeps track of which file belongs to which page and detects where changes have been made.

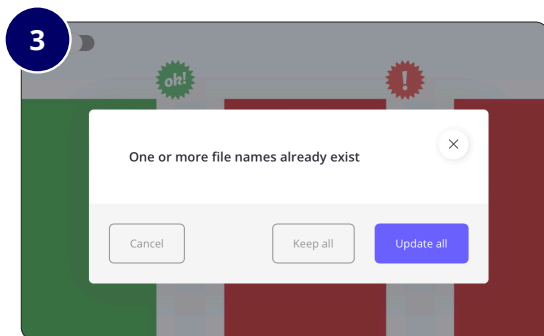
Minimize your workload - you save time by letting the system manage all updates and versions, you do not have to keep track of the number of updates per page and you do not need to save all versions separately in different folders.



For example, you have uploaded a PDF that consists of three pages, one of which is approved and two pages that need to be changed according to status.



Once the changes have been made, upload the new version, preferably by dragging and dropping the file in the tab.



The system detects that the document already exists as the file has an unchanged file name compared to the previous version. Here, you can choose to either upload the document as new* files via "Keep all", or update the existing pages as a new version via "Update all".



The system compares and detects which pages have been changed and updates these, but retains the already approved/unchanged pages.

*) With "Keep all" the pages are placed as new files in the same tab. You might only choose this when you want duplicate pages, for some reason.
