



Swim Coach of the Year Selection Criterion

1. There shall be three awards presented annually by Swim Nova Scotia. One each to Development Coach, a High-Performance Coach and a PARA Coach:
 - “Speedo Performance Coach of the Year”
 - “Speedo NSSCA Development Coach of the Year”
 - “Speedo PARA Coach of the Year”
2. The awards shall be announced annually in October.
3. A) Speedo Performance Coach of the Year: Selection to be made by Swim Nova Scotia based on the following:
 - i. Coach of record for highest absolute ranked able-bodied swimmer (based on SNC Online Rankings)
 - ii. Accomplishments to take place during the SNC published performance windows.
 - iii. If there is a dispute for the Coach of Record for a swimmer’s performance, the swimmer shall be consulted.
- B) Speedo NSSCA Development Coach of the Year:
 - i. Nominations to be made by NSSCA members
 - ii. Accomplishments to take place during the SNC published performance windows.
 - iii. One vote per member of the NSSCA
- C) Speedo PARA Coach of the Year:
 - i. Coach of record for the highest ranked PARA Swimmer from the IPC World rankings
 - ii. Accomplishments to take place during the SNC published performance windows.
 - iii. If there is a dispute for the Coach of Record for a swimmer’s performance, the swimmer shall be consulted.
4. Coach (Able-Bodied & PARA) eligibility:
 - a) NCCP Level II Swimming Certified or equivalent (Speedo Performance Coach of the Year & PARA Coach of the Year), NCCP Level I Swimming Certified or equivalent (Speedo NSSCA Development Coach of the Year)
 - b) Member in good standing Swim Nova Scotia/NSSCA, SNC, CSCTA
 - c) Resident in Nova Scotia for 12 consecutive months
