PACKING LIST

- A valid, current U.S. Passport (Please submit your passport at our meeting on March 17th.)
 - Face masks and personal hand sanitizer
 - Sleeping bag, pillow & small camping pad (air or foam)
 - Warm clothes for cold nights
 - Comfortable clothes for relaxing at camp (nothing nice!)
 - Work clothes that can get dirty or ruined
 - Long pants (required)
 - Short sleeve shirts (Sorry no tank tops)
 - Sturdy closed-toed shoes (required)
 - Work gloves
- Tools are not necessary but hammer, pencil, and "square" are nice to have



- Water bottle
- Sunscreen (A hat is a big help too!)
- Towel & toiletries (soap, shampoo, etc.)
- "Sun Shower" from sporting goods store (recommended)
- Swim suit for showers (required)
- Flashlight (we also recommend a headlamp flashlight)
- Bible
- Cash for 4 meals on the road (and a little extra for souvenirs, snacks if desired)
- Large trash bags to pack dirty clothes
- Rain poncho (just in case!)
- Cell Phone? We are okay with you bringing them to keep in touch with parents. The goal of the trip is to unplug from technology. **There are no outlets for charging.** CPC is not responsible for lost, broken or stolen phones.

(especially your solar shower)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Not too much stuff! (Please pack light- you need to be able to carry it!)
- No large or hard-sided luggage (space under the bus is very limited) but wheels are great!
- No large inflatable mattress or cots! (there is no room in your tent for an aero bed), just buy a nice camping pad instead.

And of course...

- NO drugs
- NO alcohol
- NO vapes
- NO weapons of any kind
- NO bad attitude

Pack as light as you can! Soft-sided rolling duffel bags are ideal. You MUST be able to carry (roll, drag) everything of yours through the border crossing.
