Virginia pregnancy centers provide free medical, counseling, and support services for women and their partners. These services strengthen families and ensure women have the resources they need for a healthy and hope-filled future.

## Snapshot of Virginia Pregnancy Centers:

 **39**  
centers

The 39 pregnancy centers located throughout the Commonwealth are helping women and families in need every day.

 **14,145**  
clients served

In 2018, Virginia pregnancy centers assisted 14,145 women and their partners with free services.

**\$3.2 million**  
in free services provided

Virginia pregnancy centers provided over \$3.2 million in free services and support to Virginia families in 2018 at no cost to taxpayers.

99% of individuals using pregnancy center services indicated on exit surveys that they had a positive experience.

**Pregnancy Testing**

Virginia pregnancy centers assisted **9,500 women** with free pregnancy testing services in 2018.



**Ultrasounds & STI Testing**

Over **5,700** ultrasounds & **800** STI tests were performed in 2018 by licensed medical professionals, equipping women with medical clarity during pregnancy decisions.



**Pregnancy & Parenting Education**

Approximately **7,000** parenting and life skill classes were provided in 2018 to women and their partners through Virginia pregnancy centers.



**Essential Baby Supplies**

Virginia families were furnished with over **72,000** free baby items in 2018, including diapers, wipes, baby clothes, equipment, and more.

**59,000**  
hours volunteered

Over **900** volunteers, including over **90** licensed medical professionals, served at local pregnancy centers in 2018. They donated **59,000** volunteer hours to support and empower families.



**\$10 million**  
generously donated

Over **24,000** individuals and **2,500** churches and organizations donated **\$10 million** to Virginia pregnancy centers in 2018.
