## PARENTAL RIGHTS BILLS DEFEATED BY SENATE ED. & HEALTH COMMITTEE

**HB 787 – Anti–CRT Education –** Prohibited school boards or employees from using a curriculum that teaches students one race is inherently superior to another.

**SB 766 – Protect Women's Sports –** Prohibited biological males from competing in all-female interscholastic K–12 sports teams.

**HB 511 – Tebow Bill –** Allowed local schools to permit homeschool students to participate in public school sports.

**HB 789 – FLE Opt–in (sex education) –** Required schools to obtain permission from parents for their child to participate in Family Life Education.

**SB 570 – Prohibit Divisive Concepts –** Required public school principals to ensure no curriculum or instructional lessons includes inherently divisive concepts, like "Critical Race Theory".

**HB 1034** – Parental Permission for School Counseling – Required DOE to write guidelines requiring parental notification and consent for school counseling.

**SB 20 – Optional "Transgender" Policies –** Conformed to a recent Lynchburg circuit court ruling to allow schools the option not to adopt DOE's model policies for the treatment of "transgender" students in public elementary and secondary schools.

**HB 356 - Charter School Expansion -** Made it easier to create more charter schools.

**HB 1024** – **Education Savings Account** – Created education savings accounts for qualified students to use for certain education–related expenses, including tuition, deposits, fees, and required textbooks at a private elementary school or secondary school located in the Commonwealth.

**HB 294 – Expand School Choice Tax Credit –** Amended the existing education scholarship tax credit to allow funds to be used for students seeking a safer public school option.

**SB 275** – **School Library Book Oversight** – Required school divisions to adopt policies to allow parental review of printed and audiovisual materials made available in public school libraries.
