## **WORSHIP PASTOR- ROLE DESCRIPTION- 2023**

**OUR PURPOSE -** We exist to help people experience a life-giving relationship with Jesus and for that to positively impact their lives and the world around them.

**Role Purpose** - The role of the Worship Pastor is to oversee and develop the worshipping life of St Matt's through music and creativity, enabling people to encounter God and deepen their faith.

Creative Team Leaders and team members Production and Media team members

#### 1) Leadership

- Together with the Vicar and Executive Director, the Worship Pastor will be involved in prayerfully leading the church forward, discerning God's direction and embodying the church's Vision, Mission and Values.
- Alongside the Vicar, Executive Director and the Leadership team, they will be responsible for prayerfully discerning God's will and direction for the worshipping life of the church, the direction and pastoring of both the Worship and Production team members.
- Attend weekly Staff team meetings, participate in all additional prayer meetings, Kingdom Come nights and other ad hoc events such as Love South West.
- Attend 1-2-1 meetings with the Executive Director or as required.

#### • Worship & Production

- Lead, develop and set the culture of both the Worship & Production teams; recognising, valuing and releasing gifting in others; developing skill and confidence in the teams and pursuing the presence of God with authenticity and excellence.
- Oversee, develop and ensure provision of Worship & Production at church services and other events including but not limited to - Sunday Services, Kids, Nights of Worship & Prayer and special events as needed.
- Oversee and develop the Worship Team, identifying and appointing new Worship Team Leaders & Team Members.
- Lead Worship Leader meetings to discuss forthcoming events, support them pastorally and lead the heart and vision of the team.
- Organise and oversee Worship & Production team nights ensuring the team are supported, resourced, trained and equipped as needed.
- o Organise weekly Worship Team rehearsals.
- Pastoral oversight of Worship & Production team members.
- Maintain and develop AV equipment ensuring all equipment is cared for, cleaned and organised. This includes ensuring the stage area is kept clean, tidy and organised.
- Maintain CCLI records & submit our annual return.
- Oversee provision of Worship & Production for ad hoc events e.g: Light Party, Festivals (Midweek Easter & Christmas events etc.), Conferences and Team Training Nights.
