In 1992, Spokane witnessed a pivotal moment with its inaugural Pride Parade. Inspired by the 1969 Stonewall riots, around two hundred locals marched bravely through the streets to be seen, heard, and accepted, many concealing their identities out of fear.

We commemorate Pride Month to honor those who fought for us, recognizing their struggles and sacrifices. Pride is a time for celebration, remembrance,

and advocacy. It's a moment to educate and raise awareness about LGBTQIA+ issues and history. We hold space for those lost to the AIDS epidemic and anti-LGBTQIA+ violence, and we advocate for a future where everyone can live authentically.

By being unapologetically ourselves, we pay homage to those who never had the chance. To honor Spokane's first marchers and all who were forced to hide, we promise to never stop being who we are. We will never go back. We are ***Never Gonna Hide***

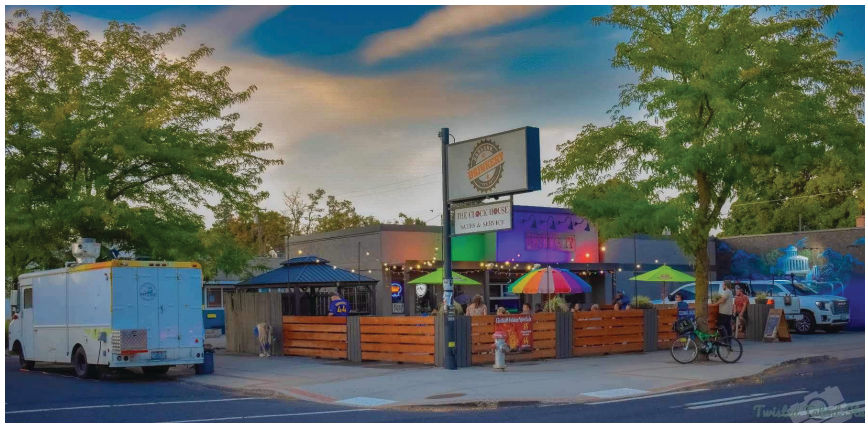
