CONGREGATION: Amen.

CLERGY: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost be with you all.

CONGREGATION: And with your spirit.

THE ANTIPHON

CLERGY: reads antiphon of the day

CONFITEOR

CLERGY: Brothers and sisters, let us now confess our sins, and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the Sacred Mysteries.

**ALL: I confess to Almighty God,
to blessed Mary ever Virgin,
to blessed Michael the Archangel
to blessed John the Baptist,
to the holy Apostles Peter and Paul,
to all the Saints, and to you, brethren,
that I have sinned exceedingly
in thought, word and deed:
through my fault, through my fault,
through my most grievous fault.
Therefore I beseech blessed Mary ever Virgin,
blessed Michael the Archangel,
blessed John the Baptist,
the holy Apostles Peter and Paul,
all the Saints, and you, brethren,
to pray for me to the Lord our God.**

CLERGY: Let us pray. Heavenly Father, be merciful unto us, forgive our sins, and bring us unto life everlasting. Grant us pardon, absolution, and remission of sins, in the name of God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost.

CONGREGATION: Amen.

CLERGY: Thou, O Lord, being turned toward us, wilt enliven us.

CONGREGATION: And Thy people will rejoice in Thee.

CLERGY: Show us, O Lord, Thy mercy.

CONGREGATION: And grant us Thy salvation.

CLERGY: O Lord, hear my prayer.

CONGREGATION: And let my cry come unto Thee.

CLERGY: The Lord be with you.

CONGREGATION: And with Thy spirit.

CLERGY: Lord have mercy.

ALL: Lord have mercy.

CLERGY: Christ have mercy.

THE GLORIA

ALL:

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will.

We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory,

Lord God, heavenly King, O God almighty Father.

Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world,

Have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer;

You are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.

For You alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Ghost, in the glory of God the Father. Amen.

THE COLLECT

CLERGY: reads the collect of the day.

CONGREGATION: Amen.

THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

OLD TESTAMENT READING

READER: Announces “A reading from the book of...Chapter..., verses...”

[first reading is read]

READER: [when finished] The Word of the Lord.

CONGREGATION: Thanks be to God.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM

[Psalm of the day is either read or sung]

EPISTLE READING

READER: Announces “A reading from the book of...Chapter...verses...”

[first reading is read]

READER: [when finished] The Word of the Lord.

CONGREGATION: Thanks be to God.

ACCLAMATION BEFORE THE GOSPEL

GOSPEL READER: [Crosses himself] Cleanse my heart and my lips, O Almighty God, who didst cleanse the lips of the prophet Isaiah with a burning coal from Thine altar, and vouchsafe, through thy gracious mercy, so to purify me, that I may worthily attend to Thy Holy Gospel. Through Christ our Lord, Amen. May the Lord be in my heart and on my lips, that I may worthily, and in a becoming manner, attend to his Holy Gospel. Amen.

CONGREGATION: Alleluia, alleluia [singing]

SINGER: [sings daily acclamation]

CONGREGATION: Alleluia, alleluia [singing]

GOSPEL READER: The Lord be with you.

CONGREGATION: And with your spirit

THE READING OF THE GOSPEL

GOSPEL READER: A reading from the Holy Gospel according to...[crossing himself at + forehead, + lips and + breast].

CONGREGATION: Glory be to Thee, O Lord.

[Gospel is proclaimed]

GOSPEL READER: The Gospel of the Lord.

CONGREGATION: Praise be to Thee, O Christ.

GOSPEL READER: [kissing Gospel book]

CLERGY: Through the words of the Gospel may our sins be wiped away.

THE HOMILY

CLERGY: In the Name of the Father + and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost.

CONGREGATION: Amen.

[The homily is given]

CLERGY: And now to God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost, Three Persons in one God, be ascribed, as is most justly due, All Honor, Might, Majesty, Power, and Dominion, Now, henceforth, and for ever more.

CONGREGATION: Amen.

THE ACT OF FAITH

CLERGY: Let us now recite together the Apostle's Creed.

ALL: I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,

Who was conceived by the Holy Ghost, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried;

He descended into hell;

On the third day he rose again from the dead;

He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there he will come to judge the quick and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Ghost, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.

Amen.

THE OUR FATHER

CLERGY: The Lord be with you.

CONGREGATION: And with your spirit.

CLERGY: At the Savior's command and informed by divine teaching we dare to say –

ALL:

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy Name,

Thy kingdom come, Thy Will be done, on earth, as it is in Heaven.

Give us this day, our daily Bread, and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those, who trespass against us.

And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.

For the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, are yours, now, and forever.

Amen.

THE COMMUNION RITE

CLERGY: Let us pray. O God, who in this wonderful Sacrament of the altar hast left us a living memorial of thy passion, grant us so to venerate the sacred mysteries of Thy Body and Blood, that we may ever feel within ourselves the fruit of thy redemption; who livest and reignest with the Father, in the unity of the Holy Ghost, God forever and ever.

ALL: Amen.

[[CLERGY: BRAKE HOST in half over the Chalice, and with a small Particle thereof MAKE the Sign of the Cross, THRICE, over the CHALICE, and finally at the words 'eternal life' drops the Particle into the Chalice...]]

CLERGY: ++ May this mixture and consecration of the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ be to us that receive it, effectual to eternal life. Amen.

[[CLERGY communicates in both kinds: "The Body and Blood ++ of our Lord Christ, Keep Thee unto Life Eternal."]]

[The CLERGY blesses the people with a Particle, as he says:]

CLERGY: ++ Ye that desire to partake of the Body of the Lord, draw nigh and receive this most holy Sacrament.

[He administers the Holy Communion to them in the usual manner and when all have received, he says:]

CLERGY: The Body ++ of our Lord Christ keep thee unto life eternal.

POSTCOMMUNIO

CONGREGATION: Amen.

CLERGY: Almighty and ever living GOD, we thank Thee for having fed us in these Holy Mysteries with the spiritual food of the most precious body and blood of Thy Son, our Savior Jesus Christ, having assured us of Thy favor and goodness toward us, that we might be members in Thy Mystical Body, which is the blessed company of all faithful people, and heirs through hope of Thy everlasting kingdom, by the merits of the most precious death and passion, of Thy Dear Son. We most humbly beseech Thee, O Heavenly Father, to assist us with Thy grace, that we may continue in holy fellowship, and do all such good works as Thou hast prepared for us to walk in: through Jesus Christ our Lord, to whom with Thee and the Holy Ghost, be all honor and glory, world without end. Let us take a moment in silence to offer our personal prayers and commune privately in the holy temple within.

CLERGY: [after delay rings bells]

ALL: Amen.

ADDITIONAL PRAYERS FOR HEALING

CLERGY: [Offers prayers as necessary and appropriate for Congregation, friends, family, benefactors, etc.]

Let us pray: Blessed be + the great Mother of God, Mary most holy; May the Queen of Heaven, intercede for us, with the Lord our God. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now, and at the hour, of our death.

ALL: Amen.

[1] O Father of mercies, and God of all comfort, our only help in time of need: We humbly beseech Thee to behold, visit, and relieve, Thy sick servants for whom our prayers are desired.

ALL: Amen.

[2] Look upon them with the eyes of mercy; comfort them with a sense of Thy goodness; preserve them from the temptations of the enemy; and give them patience under their affliction.

ALL: Amen.

[3] In Thy good time, restore them to health, and enable them to lead the residue of their life in Thy fear, and to Thy glory; and grant that finally they may dwell with Thee in life ever-lasting; Through Jesus Christ our Lord.

ALL: Amen.

[4] Almighty God, look on your servants, drawing near death of the flesh, lying in great weakness, and comfort them with the promise of life ever-lasting, given in the resurrection of your Son Jesus Christ, our Lord.

ALL: Amen.

[5] Heavenly Father, giver of life and health: Comfort and relieve your sick servants for whom our prayers are offered; and give your power of healing to those who minister to their needs, that they may be strengthened in their weakness, and have confidence in your loving care; Through Jesus Christ our Lord.

ALL: Amen.

CLERGY: Lord Jesus, Bread of Life, By the power, of this Holy Communion & its promise, of life ever-lasting, Deliver those, for whom we pray, from the death, that lasts for ever. May the souls, of the faithful departed, through the Mercy of God + rest in peace. Into your hands, O Lord Christ, we commend our brothers and sisters.

ALL: Amen.

PRAYER OF ST. MICHAEL THE ARCHANGEL

ALL: "Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil; May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; And do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, thrust into hell Satan and all evil spirits who wander through the world for the ruin of souls. Amen."

PRAYER OF ST. BARACHIEL THE ARCHANGEL

ALL: "O Powerful Angel, St. Barachiel, filled with heaven's glory and splendor, you are rightly called God's Benediction. We are God's children placed under your protection and care. Listen to our supplications and grant that, through your loving intercession, we might reach our heavenly home one day. Sustain and protect us from all harm that we may possess all eternity the peace and happiness Jesus has prepared for us in heaven. Present to God the Father all our petitions through Jesus Christ our Lord, together with the Holy Ghost, forever and ever. Amen."

THE BENEDICTION

CLERGY: Let us pray. The peace of God, which passeth all understanding, keep our hearts and minds in the knowledge of love of God, and of His Son, Christ our Lord; and the blessing of God Almighty, the Father, + the Son, and the Holy Ghost, be amongst us and remain with us always.

CONGREGATION: Amen.

CLERGY: Brothers and sisters, let us now go in peace, glorifying the Lord by our lives.
