

Summary Bullet Points:

The EC raised the following concerns regarding Guidepost's initial contract:

1. Waiver of Attorney-Client privilege
2. The indemnification language
3. Lack of EC oversight

The Task Force in good faith worked to address the issues, and has made significant concessions, which have been included in a modified contract. The EC's concerns were addressed in the following manner:

1. The EC has agreed to waive its Attorney-Client privilege related to matters within the scope of the Motion (which are the only documents Guidepost is entitled to request).
2. Indemnification: The scope of indemnification language was narrowed.
3. The current contract provides for EC oversight in the following areas:
 - a. The current contract states that the SBC, through and under the leadership of the Task Force, has retained Guidepost
 - b. Creation of the Committee on Cooperation (comprised of EC members)
 - c. Financial oversight of Guidepost's invoice (without details into investigative activity)
 - d. Limited review of factual portions of report for accuracy only
