Summary Bullet Points:

The EC raised the following concerns regarding Guidepost's initial contract:

- 1. Waiver of Attorney-Client privilege
- 2. The indemnification language
- 3. Lack of EC oversight

The Task Force in good faith worked to address the issues, and has made significant concessions, which have been included in a modified contract. The EC's concerns were addressed in the following manner:

- The EC has agreed to waive its Attorney-Client privilege related to matters within the scope of the Motion (which are the only documents Guidepost is entitled to request).
- 2. Indemnification: The scope of indemnification language was narrowed.
- 3. The current contract provides for EC oversight in the following areas:
 - a. The current contract states that the SBC, through and under the leadership of the Task Force, has retained Guidepost
 - b. Creation of the Committee on Cooperation (comprised of EC members)
 - c. Financial oversight of Guidepost's invoice (without details into investigative activity)
 - d. Limited review of factual portions of report for accuracy only
