Estimated Cost of Attendance

What does the Cost of Attendance mean?

The cost of attendance at LCOOU varies based on individual student circumstances. The Financial Aid Office creates a student's financial aid offer based on a cost of attendance which includes expenses directly billed by the university (tuition/fees, and books) and non-billed education expenses (transportation, supplies, and miscellaneous/personal expenses if applicable). The cost of attendance will include allowances for housing and food along with the other components. The Cost of Attendance is only used for financial aid purposes and will not necessarily reflect actual charges. The Business Office will publish tuition and fees once they are finalized (usually mid-July for the upcoming fall term).
