



For fifty years, the state of Montana administered the Federal Title X program, which provides money and support to family planning clinics across the state so they can provide accessible, affordable care to anyone in need. As of this April, Bridgercare took over the Title X program in order to prevent political agendas from getting in the way of people's health care. This program is now managed by an arm of Bridgercare called Montana Family Planning and currently supports a network of two dozen clinics all over Montana.
