Romans 1:16-17

1: What does it look like to be ashamed of the Gospel?

2: What does it look like to live by faith?

Exodus 3:1-6

3: Read Exodus 19. Compare these two instances of holy ground.

4: Moses hid his face and was afraid to look at God. Fear here is tied to reverence. Answer and discuss, "Do we have this same reverence for God?"

Isaiah 57:14-19

5: God names Himself Holy. This is both a name and an attribute of God's character. How does this affect the relationship God has with the nation of Israel?

6: How did God fulfill His promise in verses 18-19?

7: What does it mean that God is holy?

Romans 1:18-23

8: How does creation leave mankind without excuse?

Romans 2:1-6

9: How does the ability to make moral judgements leave mankind without excuse?

10: Vs 6 is sometimes used in a positive light. People are repaid for the good that they do. What does this verse mean in light of the surrounding context?

Romans 2:17-24

11: Because of Israel's unbelief God's name is blasphemed among the nations. When we live in unbelief do we do the same thing?

Romans 3:9-20

12: What is the conclusion to the state of mankind that we see in this passage?

13: Vs 19-20, Can the law make us righteous? Can the law maintain our righteousness?
Romans 3:21-31

14: How is righteousness obtained?

15: Do the Israelites, God's chosen people, obtain righteousness in a different way than the rest of the world?

1 Corinthians 15:1-4

16: What is the gospel?

17: Discuss why you think Paul would bring up the message of the gospel again and so near the end of his letter.

2 Corinthians 5:16-21

18: What is the message of reconciliation?

19: What does it look like to be Christ's ambassador?
