HUBs are locations where individuals and families experiencing homelessness can come in to have a conversation with an Intake Specialist to explore resources and supports to keep them off the streets or out of the shelters.

- Services are not provided at the time of visit nor guaranteed
- First come, first seen until capacity is reached
- The entire family does not need to be present, only the head of household
