A few words from the Board President...



I had the pleasure of attending the February program, which examined how creativity influences and builds our leadership skills. Facilitator Morgan McArthur led with a discussion that asked members of the cohort to share their reflections about what SCIL has taught them.

Their responses were “off the scale wonderful”! 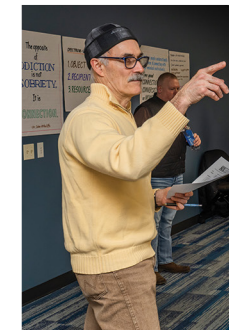
