Bible Verses

Acts 4:12 “And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”

Romans 6:23 “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Romans 5:8 “but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

John 3:16 “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.”

Discussion – The Greatest Gift of All

Multiple times in history, the Jewish nation was given the gift of a second chance to come back under God’s wings of grace, blessing, and forgiveness after their rebellious disobedience to his Word. In most cases Israel failed to take advantage of their second chances and continued to do what was right in their own eyes.

On November 5, 2024, God gave America the gift of a second chance. America is at a crossroads and must choose whether we will be blessed or cursed by God. If we choose to follow God’s laws, precepts, and ways as outlined in the Holy Bible, we can look forward to an overflowing abundant blessing on our nation. If we choose to put our trust in man and do what is right in our own eyes, we can look forward to distressing disaster and a curse.

Every empire in history that followed man’s ways has ultimately fallen and failed. There is only one gift and one empire that will never fail. The prophet Daniel talks about it in Daniel 2:44-45, “And in the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that shall never be destroyed, nor shall the kingdom be left to another people. It shall break in pieces

all these kingdoms and bring them to an end, and it shall stand forever, just as you saw that a stone was cut from a mountain by no human hand, and that it broke in pieces the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver, and the gold.” That stone was the cornerstone, Jesus Christ, and America must embrace the cornerstone if we are to thrive and prosper as a nation.

Jesus Christ, the greatest gift of all times, is described in Hebrews 1:3, *“He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and He upholds the universe by the word of His power. After making purification for sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.”* Jesus’s power and creativity is further described in Colossians 1:15-18, *“He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.”* Nothing can and nothing ever will compare to the greatest gift of all times, salvation through belief in Jesus Christ and being accepted into God’s eternal family.

- Sealed us with the Holy Spirit to guide and lead us (Ephesians 1:13-14)
- Made us kings and priest to His God and Father (Revelation 1:5-6)
